 your letter which gave me greale Satisfaction
 to Recieve a line from you when I Recived your letter
 I was being very sick and I got a nother person
 to answer it and I hardly no any thing that was
 in it I wante you to visit my son often and
 and converse with him pray for him and with
 him and I desire and intruste in your prayers
 that I may holde out faith ful and may be
 rebeld No have my trubbel and affliction look-
 -ing unto god continually for supporting grace in all
 things I wante you to see the governer and inter-
 -sede with the govener for him the govener has all
 of the papers with with the affidaver of four
 or five Respected men as there is in Cincinnati
 which has none him from a while I wish you
 to see them and read them the were taken on to the
 govener by one of ~~the~~ the judges of the late
 Brother Johnson and Brother Linnover and both
 Methodu L. L. L. leader who has sente on their
 affidaver I wante you to write to ^{me} immediately
 how my son is and how things are going on
