Cincinnati April the 21 day 1849 AD  
Brother of B finley my Son dear brother and thanks  
to you for the intress you have taken in the well-  
fane of my Son both Soal and bodily I Reservd  
your letter which gave mee grete Satisfaction  
to Reserv a line from you when I Resvd your letter  
I was having very sick and I got a nother person  
to answer it and I hardly no any thing that was  
in it I wante you to viset my son often and  
and howerer with him pray for him and with  
him and I desire and intreaste in yourn ware  
that I may hold out faith ful and may be  
cubled No bane my troubles and afflictions look-  
ing unto god constantly for Supporting grace in all  
thing I wante you to see the govt and inter-  
-seel with the governer for him the governer has all  
of the papers with with the affidavets of four  
or five respectabel men as there is in cincinata  
which has none him from a while I wish you  
to see them and read them the ware taken on to the  
governer by one of the the judges of the court  
Brother Johnson and Brother Linnier are both  
Methodist leuis leader who has sente on their  
affidavets I wante you to Rite to me immediately  
how my son is and how things are going on  
yours most affectionately
