169 Henderson County April 16th 1830

Dear Sir

My mother requested me to
send on a note, of hers to you, on
John L. Gordon, to receive the money
on it, if you please; he told me
to send his note on to some friend
in Cincinnati, and he would pay it off
by the 1st of May; my mother preferred you
to any one else there, and wished the note
sent on to you, you will please be so
good as to receive the money and first
pay your self for your trouble and ~~send~~
~~deposit~~ the rest in the bank at Cincinnati
to and get a check on the bank of Phila

- Delphia and send it on to me by male
direct your letter to Henderson City, Ky,
if you can make that arrangement,
if not please let me know by the first
male
