Dear Bro.

Yours communications of the 5th Inst. we received yesterday. We readily thank you always for your hasty attention to our business; but greatly regret that you had not forwarded the money, for we are in pressing want, & made our calculation on the remittance from the Ohio Conference. And we must now suffer, unless we can borrow, which indeed is very difficult. We fear you did not receive our communication, or no doubt you would have forwarded the money immediately. This therefore, is to desire you to lose no time in procuring a draft or Treasury Notes, & forward the amount as soon as may be.
