
Class Interactions






Do You Feel Comfortable Talking about Politics with Professors on Campus?



DO YOU THINK YOUR POLITICAL VIEWS AFFECT YOUR GRADE IN CLASS?


Do You Think Your Political Views Affect Your Grade in Class?






Have You Ever Chosen to Not Share Your Opinion in Class?


Why Respondents Chose Not to Share Their Opinion






Do You Feel that Your Freedom of Speech is Limited on OWU's


Do You Feel Comfortable Talking about Politics with Students on Campus?




Why Students Do Not Feel Comfortable Talking about Politics with Other Students




Why Students Felt Comfortable Talking about Politics with Other Students




Why Students Sometimes Felt Comfortable Talking about Politics with Other Students






Do you take classes that challenge your personal opinions?


Do You feel Ostracized due to Your Political View?
