### K. E. A. ELECTS KEITH PRESIDENT

Louisville, April 26.—Provision for committees to carry on its work until the next meeting in 1925 and election of officers with Charles A. Keith, of the Eastern State Normal School and Teacher's College, Richmond, as president, marked the close today of the most largely attended annual meeting of the Kentucky Educational Association.

Keith was opposed for president by Judson Jenkins, of Davidson Springs, and won by a vote of 375 to 241. He is professor of history and political science at the eastern normal school.

Other officers elected were Mrs. E. B. Bohner, Mayaville, first vice president; J. T. Miracle, Catlettsburg, second vice president; J. M. Gwyn, Hickman, third vice president; W. Bradner, Middlesboro, and H. H. Cherry, Bowling Green, were elected directors of the 1925 convention.

A new constitution will be submitted to the 1925 convention.

Crisp, Greenville, Ky.; Clint Cable, Columbus Miss.; T. R. Cable, city; Joe and Carl Rowlett, city. Two sisters also survive: Mrs. Martha Barnes and Mrs. Mary Thomas, both of Stewart county. The sympathy of friends is extended to the bereaved family.

J. M. Finney, 70 years of age died last Saturday afternoon at his home near Newberg. Burial took place Sunday at Friendship. Surviving are two sons and three daughters.

In the elections of last year he defeated by a two to one vote his opponent in the race for associate editor, the position which he has held this year. As the present associate editor he has been the make-up man for the Wheel, having written or supervised all the headlines appearing in the Wheel. Several times during the year his contributions to the editorial columns have won the appreciation of the Wheel readers."

### BONUS BILL GIVEN O. K. IN SENATE, 67-17.

Washington, April 24.—The Senate, following in the footsteps of the House, passed the soldier bonus bill yesterday by a majority sufficient to carry it over a Presidential veto. The vote was 67 to 17.

President Coolidge has declared against a bonus, but proponents of this particular kind of adjusted compensation legislation are hopeful that it will meet with his approval. Before the bill reaches him, however, it must go to conference for adjustment of differences with the House.

Assured Republican leaders that they would vote to override a veto of this bill, but would support a veto of a cash bonus measure the Senate resisted all efforts to add a cash option.

The test on this question came with the rejection, 48 to 37, of an amendment by Senator Copeland, Democrat, New York, which would have left with the former service men the choice of full cash payments or the insurance certificates provided for in both the Senate and House bills.

Many Democratic Senators who voted for the measure in its present form denounced it as a "miserable makeshift" and a "gold brick" and formal notice was given that at some future time efforts would be made to amend it so as to allow the veterans to get cash.

On the final veto on the bill the Democrats and eight Republicans opposed it, while 33 Republicans and 32 Democrats and the two Farmer-Labor Senators supported it.

### Lexington Gets State Convention May 14.

Lexington, Ky., April 26.—The Democratic State Central and Executive Committees in joint session assembled here today afternoon, decided to change the place of convention from Louisville to Lexington, on the previously announced date, May 14th.

### OFFICIAL CALL FOR COUNTY CONVENTION.

In conformity with an official call of the Democratic State Central and Executive Committees in joint session assembled here today afternoon, I hereby issue a call upon the Democrats of Calloway county to assemble in mass convention at the court house in Murray, Ky., at 2 o'clock p.m., on the 10th day of May 1924, for the purpose of selecting delegates to attend the Democratic State Convention, which will be held in Louisville on the 14th day of May, 1924. The state convention aforesaid will be a very important one, as it will not only select delegates to the Democratic national convention to be held in New York City on June 24, to name a Democratic candidate President and vice President, and adopt a platform, but it will select members of the Democratic state central and executive committees, and adopt rules and regulations for the government of the Democratic party in this state. Therefore I trust that we shall have a large attendance at this county convention, in order that Calloway may have a truly representative delegation, instructed in accordance with the wishes of the Democrats of Calloway county. One delegate is to be selected for each 200 votes or major fraction thereof, cast in the Presidential election of 1920. The Democratic vote in this election was 4,574. Therefore Calloway is entitled to 23 delegates to this State Convention.

The law is that Administrators should settle their administration within two years.
