New ICP Curriculum Changes:

The ICP department has made some adjustments to our curriculum to ensure that our degrees comply with recent changes in BBS licensing requirements. Below please find the details of the changes, which mostly pertain to the course work that you were able to take after graduation and prior to licensure (i.e. Spousal and Partner Abuse, Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse and Child Abuse Assessment workshops, Human Sexuality as well as Psychopharmacology).

If you started the ICP program in Fall 2011, Spring 2012 or earlier:

You are required to take the Spousal Partner Abuse workshop prior to graduation. Please plan on taking this workshop through Public Programs or through a BBS approved institution. If you take it through Public Programs the class will be automatically added to your transcript. If you take the class at another institution please submit your certification of completion to the registration office prior to graduation.

You can take the remaining workshops and Psychopharmacology after graduation. Once you submit your MFT Intern application to the BBS they will send you a letter listing all the workshops and coursework you need to take prior to submitting your 3000 hours for licensure.

If you started the program between Fall 2012 and Spring 2014:

Starting August 2012, the BBS requires the additional course work to be incorporated into the MA Psychology curriculum, so no additional workshops are needed.

We have incorporated this content into our curriculum as following:

• Spousal Partner Abuse, Child Abuse and Elder and Dependent Adult abuse is incorporated in Ethics and

- Law, Multicultural Counseling and Integrative Seminar.
- Human Sexuality is included in Human Development and Couple Counseling.
- CIIS is in the process of creating a one day Psychopharmacology workshop that will be offered in spring to cover the
 needed psychopharmacology requirement. This year only, this workshop will be offered free of charge. It will NOT offer
 graduate level credits. You will receive, if you complete the workshop, a certificate of completion. Remember you do not
 need a specific number of semester units for this content (new BBS regulations). Moving forward we will incorporate the
 information in our curriculum. We will send you more information on how to enroll as soon as the information becomes
 available

ICP Psychopharmacology Spring Workshop

As we communicated in an email sent to all ICP & ICPW students on December 9, 2013, the ICP department has made some adjustments to our curriculum to ensure that our degrees comply with recent changes in BBS licensing requirements. As part of that change, students who started the ICP program after August 1, 2012 (i.e. If you started ICP/W in Fall 2012, ICP Spring 2013, ICP/W Fall 2013 or ICP Spring 2014) are required to attend the FREE one day Psychopharmacology training below. If you started the program in Fall 2011 or Spring 2012 you need to complete a graduate level psychopharmacology class for BBS licensing purposes and can do that after graduation, this workshop does not apply to you.

This workshop will cover basic information to prepare therapists to communicate effectively with clients, make referrals to prescribing professionals and play effective roles in integrative service teams, which are common in community mental health, school programs, criminal justice programs, etc...

This year only, this workshop will be offered free of charge. It will NOT offer graduate level credits, you do not need a specific number of semester units for this content. After completing the workshop you will receive a certificate of completion. It is important to keep this certificate for your records, as it demonstrates that you have fulfilled the BBS requirement.
