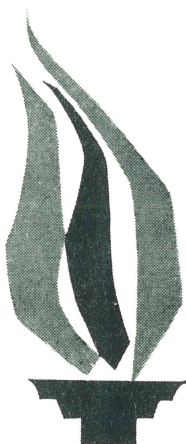

Dear Brother Chalk:


The new journal Kerygma, as you know, will make its appearance at the first of the year. As a regular feature we plan to publish, as space allows, manuscript sermons.
