Thank you very much for your letter of a recent date inquiring about the McGarvey Fellowship Program which is scheduled for our 1963 summer session. Those who are chosen will be granted an award which will pay tuition, room, and board.

For those who are interested, the six hours of work required, graduate or undergraduate, will count towards a degree; however, it is not our intention to obligate anyone to continue here or elsewhere towards a degree.

We anticipate the committee's action on the application very soon after all information has been received. This will include the data on a questionnaire sent to references that you submit.

As soon as recipients have been chosen, they will be notified immediately. We shall do this in order to give them time and opportunity to make satisfactory arrangements with the congregations where they are now serving.

Again, "thank you", and we hope you will be among those who are chosen.
