Dear Brother Chalk:

This will acknowledge and respond to your recent letter respecting the bill to amend the National Defense Education Act.

On May 6, 1963, H.R. 6074 was introduced by Rep. Powell. On February 24-25-28, and March 11, 1964, an Ad Hoc Subcommittee on the Study of Shared Time Education held hearings on this measure. The record of the proceedings, however, is being kept open until April 6, 1964, for the purpose of receiving statements from anyone interested in the measure. Should you desire to submit a statement in which you give that Subcommittee the benefit of your views regarding this legislation, I shall be pleased to transmit it on your behalf. When a Committee report is issued, I will be happy to arrange that a copy be made available to you. Enclosed is a copy of H.R. 6074, and also a copy of Public Law 85-864, which this new legislation would amend.
