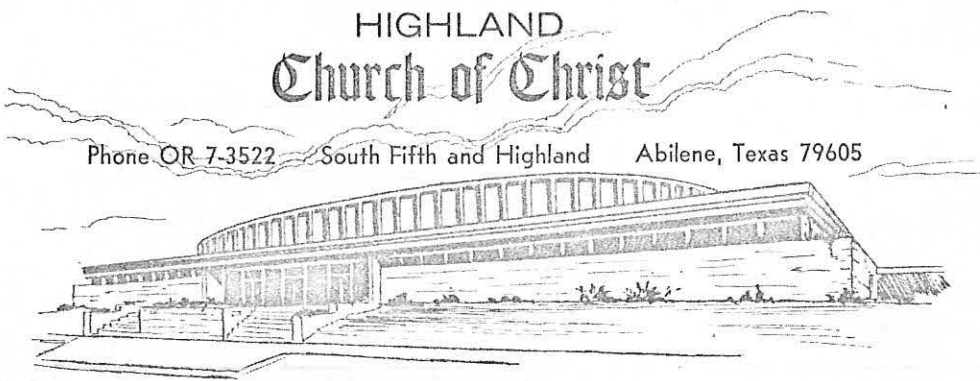

I treasure our friendship and hope that the future holds many more opportunities for our mutual service.

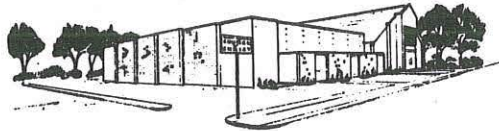
