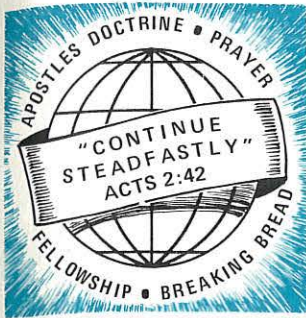
Please express my personal appreciation to your Elders for their very thoughtful gesture. Your check did amply cover the expenses I was out in trying to get to you.
