I deeply regret the tensions created in Bowling Green. I can appreciate what happened and hope and pray that already those who were greatly disturbed are having their questions answered and are coming to new insight into God's word. I continue to believe your article was Biblical and Christlike. I commend you again for it.

At this point, I know of no one I could recommend as a preacher for Park Street. I can understand the problems any man going there would face, even though I know they are nothing comparable with the opportunities. I do hope for the sake of your Indonesian work that a man who is a brother in every sense of the word can be there to bolster and encourage you and them.

I will continue to stir the fire down here regarding the money for the airplane. I will mention the matter to James Walter and will also have a prayer time with Clois Fowler about you and the entire situation with Park Street congregation. We love you and appreciate you. Already I have taken you, your family, your plans for Indonesia and the Park Street church to our Father in prayer.
