Dear John:

It was my pleasure to meet you in Abilene a few weeks ago at George Gurganus' home and as we discussed at that time, Brentwood is very much interested in pursuing with you the possibility of you and Sue going to Guatemala to spend a few days studying with our mission team people.

At this point in time the mission committee is working to formulate a definite proposal regarding this matter to present to our elders. In view of this I should like your response as to whether you and Sue can indeed go, for what period of time, when you could go, and what you would require in the way of support.

As the committee discussed this matter last Sunday the following came to the surface: 1) We feel very strongly the need of both the men and the women of this team to have a period of study ministering especially to their spiritual lives. 2) We would like for you to spend three days with the team. 3) We would like for you to give us a summary evaluation upon your return especially with regard to how Brentwood can minister more effectively to these members of our congregation. 4) We would like for at least some of our mission committee to meet with you prior to the trip. I hope these guidelines are not too cumbersome. They are negotiable so don't hesitate to question them.
