Dear John Allen:

As I was unable to attend the lectures on the inner city mission study at Harding June 19-23, I would like to know if you could supply me with any tapes, outlines, or transcripts of those lectures. Also, how would you summarize the event? Did you come up with the conclusion of the whole matter?!

Any time you can get off a few days -- vacation or otherwise -- come up and bring your family and we will go into the City for a few days and make a test run, or spy out the land.

We have a commitment from the local banks for a building loan, so we plan to begin a building within the next two weeks.

I'm sorry we have not asked you up for a gospel meeting before now -- maybe it won't be too long before we can plan on a time.

Most of our families have been here a year now and our total number including children has grown from 216 to 287. We have lost a very few families -- about four or five have moved back. There have been 34 baptisms -- mostly adults who are our friends and neighbors. Some from the door-to-door work.
