Last spring, here in Dallas, the first annual Gospel Meeting Campaign Workshop was held. It was thought that a great deal could be gained by getting together key people interested in improving campaigns and gospel meetings. The response was tremendous. Brethren from eighteen states, as far away as Massachusetts, Pennsylvania and California flew in and shared in the great feast of ideas and suggestions. Most of those who attended plan to return again, and hundreds have expressed a desire to come this May, if at all possible.

Campaigns, Inc. is again underwriting the workshop and will do so again this year although over \$1,000 was lost last year, and we only hope to break even this year. We are enclosing a tentative program drawn up before asking any speaker. Will you let us know if you can attend and speak on the topic and date indicated. We will guarantee your travel expenses and lodging while attending the workshop. If you can attend, we will need by March 15, a manuscript of what you plan to say. Each speaker will be given 45 to 50 minutes if needed.

We do hope you can attend. We expect several hundred people from all over the nation and these will be key people interested in planning gospel meetings and campaigns.
