Let me salute your efforts and thank you for being willing to publish my book, The Praying Christ and Other Sermons.

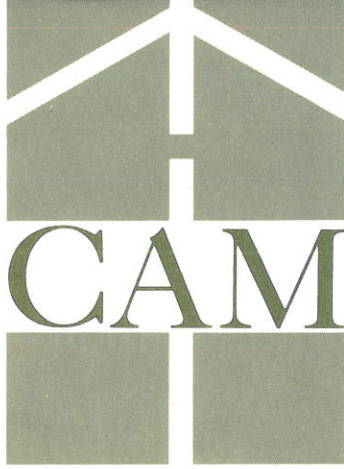
