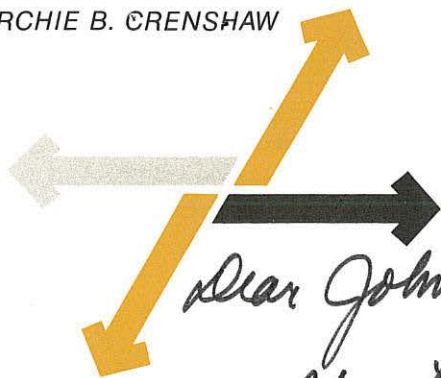

The Lord is working mightily among us. The opportunities for revolutionizing Atlanta and the Southeast are greater than ever before, and Jesus is daily opening new doors.

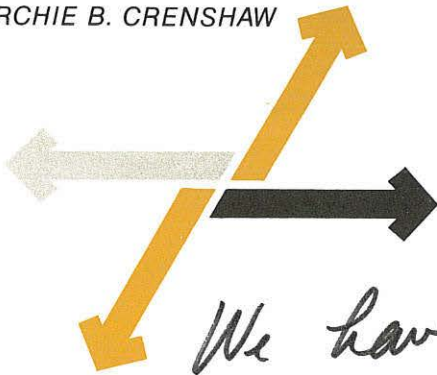
