Dear Gladys and Bob:

Thank you for your responsive letter of February 16. I am happy to know that you get to hear Herald of Truth and that the last few lessons have been meaningful to you. Your encouragement means a great deal to me.

You will receive the materials you requested under separate cover. No, I will not be attending Emory University where Thomas Altizer once taught. He is now at New York University but he did teach at Emory at the time the "God is dead" idea first arose. I will be attending Columbia Theological Seminary, a conservative Presbyterian school in Decatur, Georgia. The school is near the church with whom I will be working as a campus minister to the 24 college and university campuses in the Atlanta area. My work will be to coordinate an evangelistic thrust on all of these campuses, as well as conduct the services of "college church" which meets every Sunday morning at 8 am at the Decatur building.

I do hope Jo and Ed are doing well. They are a couple with a lot of ability. I just hope they are given more and more opportunities to serve.

I deeply regret the whispers and rumors that have circulated about me and any political affiliation. As you well know, my commitment to Christ is all-consuming. In fact, I am apolitical. I am not even sure whether I am registered as a Democrat or a Republican or even if I'm registered with any affiliation.

I do feel very strongly about the racial injustices that have been perpetrated against the black man throughout his 400 years in America. To take the situation as it now stands and say that the black men ought to act responsibly is to be grossly ignorant of what all white men have done to black men through the years. I have spent a great deal of time in Harlem, Chicago, and in Watts in Los Angeles talking to Negro Christians. I am doing everything I can to speak God's word, not a political message either to the right or to the left, to all sin in our time and that has to include the sin of racial prejudice, injustice and violence. Somehow we forget the lynching of 200 Negroes per year in the 1920's and 30's in the South when violence was being perpetrated by the Ku Klux Klan. Mr. and Mrs. Robert Swafford March 5, 1969 Page 2

No white man said anything about it, but when a few Negroes tossed some fire bombs because they found no other conceivable means of getting any progress toward their human rights, the white community started shouting Violence! with a new vehemence. I am as deeply concerned, troubled, and afraid of the radical right as I am the radical left. Communism has shown itself world wide to be split into several camps. Even though there are communistic influences in this country, and even though there are attempts by communists to take over the civil rights movement and student movements, there are conditions in this country that need to be cleaned up. I will work with these conditions as the gospel of Christ appeals to men to surrender to Jesus and to believe in God so that their lives and relationships with other men will be characterized by the love of Matthew 22:37-40. 1 don't know, however, which one I would choose if I had to make a choice between Breshnec and H.L. Hunt. A dictatorship of either stripe, either right or left, is not to my liking. But regardless of what happens in this country politically or socially, I must stand with Jesus Christ and say that I will serve Him and worship His Father and my Father regardless of the price I ultimately have to pay.

I appreciate your deep cpncern. Thank you so much for writing. Always feel free to share with me warnings, thoughts, suggestions, inspirations, and constructive criticism. I love and appreciate both of you for this kind of relationship we have had through the years. I pray that it will continue.
