Path to that goal is found in \*Gal. 5:22-26.

I. DEFINITION OF JOY: very difficult to define!!!

Column A. Religious definition: Gr. Gladness Related

Rejoicing. Exultation. Exuberance. to glory Must be possible in the presence of pain

B: Secular definition: The emotion excited by the expectation or acquisition of good.

Gladness. Delight. Good feeling. 1. SAMUEL DICKEY GORDON'S analysis:

"Joy is distinctly a Christian word. It is the reverse of happiness. Happiness is the RESULT of what happens of an agreeable sort. JOY has its springs DEEP DOWN INSIDE. And that spring NEVER runs dry, no matter what happens. Only JESUS gives that joy! He had joy, singing its music WITHIN, even under the shadow of the cross. It is an

unknown word, except as Christ has sway within the heart of the Christian." 2. SIR WILFRED GRENFELL: "Real joy comes not from lease or triches or from the praise of men. (At the end of His life Jesus had
