One of the hardest task will be, getting together the data of my Farther and Mather, as it is I know nothing of my Harther and Very little of any mather. you see I thought my mather dead until I was about 14 Sand the first time I ever remember suing fer was in 1937. Since then I have grown to love her as much as a lon ever loved his mother and to me she is the divietest, bindlest parson I have ever known and I only wish I could have grown up through childhood with her to guide Ime. In my life stary you will find that because of the life I had to live as a child I grew into manhood with more or bes the bility that I would have to fight the world in order to gain the things so dear to a mone heart. and as one blow came after the ather it only burdened my mind the more at times now I feel my self sinking back into the same frome of mind, and

I have to fight like all beck to win out over these thoughts, that is one of the many reasons that I am so interested in the welefore of the young people to day for I know just how a child's mind can become imbeded with these some thoughts. I do not yet know when my trial will be but I still have the same peace of mind as before for I know that God is with me through all of this.
