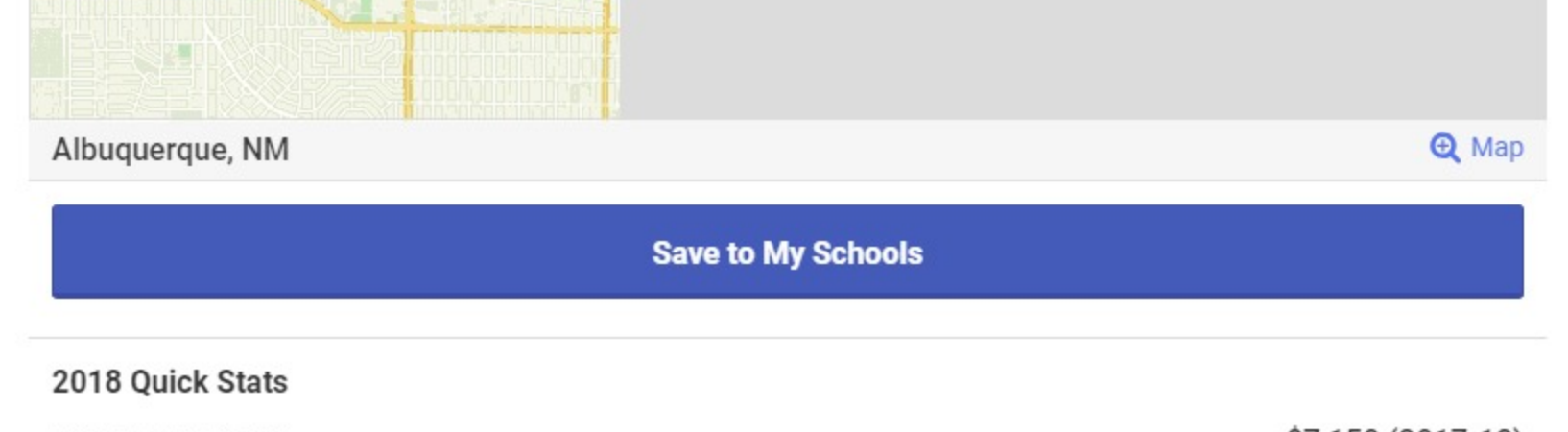

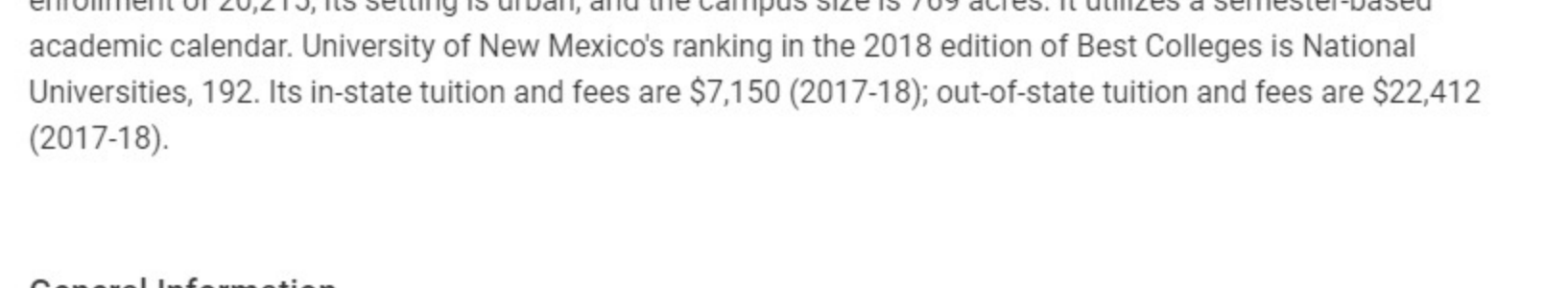

Academic Life

The student-faculty ratio at University of New Mexico is 20:1, and the school has 55.1 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at University of New Mexico include: Business, Management, Marketing, and Related Support Services; Psychology; Health Professions and Related Programs; Education; and Biological and Biomedical Sciences. The average freshman retention rate, an indicator of student satisfaction, is 79 percent.

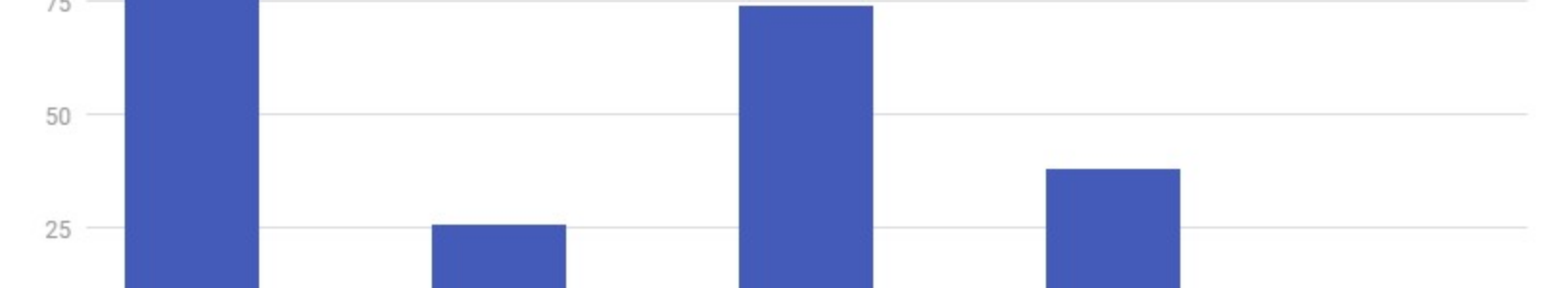

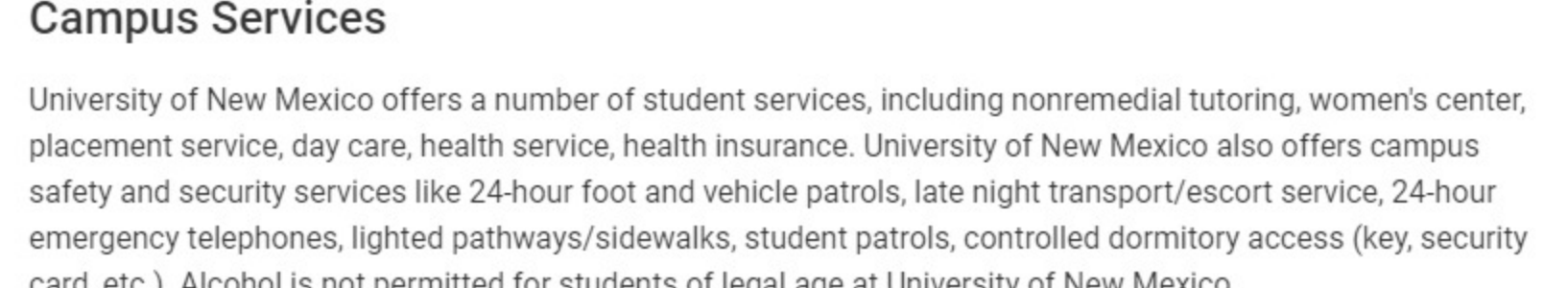
