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

EXPLOSION EN MONTEREY.
De Monterey, nuevo Leon, con
fecha reciente comunican lo si-
guiente:

"Arrojados á la eternidad en
un parpadear, once empleados
de los Ferrocarriles Nacionales
de México, fueron víctimas de
una terrible explosión en los pa-
tios locales á temprana hora de
la mañana. Hay dos hombres,
más, que, gravemente lesionados,
se encuentran en estos mo-
mentos entre la vida y la muerte.
Son los muertos: G. S. Mona-
ghan, maquinista, Manuel Fer-
nandez, mayordomo nocturno; Fran-
cisco Palacios, ayudante; Pedro Garza y Santiago Cárdenas,
mecánicos; Agapito Martínez y Porfirio Padron, ayudantes;
Juan Montes, ayudante de
maquinista; dos hombres no
identificados. Los lesionados grava-
vemente, son Catino Pérez y
Manuel Hernández, inspector.

Se cree que los lesionados morirán también.
Sobrepasada de vapor, con una
presión que no podía resistir, la
caldera de la máquina, número
2758, cuya válvula de seguridad
no quería funcionar, porestoya
vieja y en mal estado, hizo explo-
sión despedazándose en miles de
fragmentos, añadiendo una
catastrofe horrible á la numero-
sa lista de desastres ferrocarrile-
ros.

Ninguno de los que pudieran
dar informe exacto de lo que su-
cedió antes de ocurrir la ex-
plosión, vive ya, pero de los in-
formes recogidos de fuentes di-
versas y más ó menos dignas de
crédito, resulta que se habían he-
cho prevenciones, al salir la má-
quina de la casa redonda, donde
sufrió las últimas reparaciones,
de que estaba útil para servicio.
Alimentado el fuego durante tres
cuartos de hora, el manómetro
marcaba apenas veinticinco li-
bras de vapor cuando debía re-
gistrar doscientas.

Habrá caminado la locomotora
algunas docenas yardas
de la casa redonda, cuando el
maquinista advirtió algún defecto
en la válvula y el manómetro.
La válvula de seguridad arrojó
una espesa nube de vapor y
no manó braba con regularidad,
por lo que el maquinista no atre-
vió á emprender con su tren la
ruta hacia C. Victoria. Tratóse
de arreglar la válvula y al intentar
efectuarlo se sucedió la terri-
ble explosión. El frente de la má-
quina, la caja del fuego y parte
del tanque volaron en pedazos á
distancia de más de cien pies, lle-
vando consigo los cuerpos del
maquinista y de una porción de
hombres que habían venido de la
casa redonda para ayudar en la
reparación.

Al mismo tiempo la parte de-
lantera de la máquina voló á
igual distancia en dirección de la
vía ocasionando la muerte de va-
rios otros hombres.

Hoy se ven tres montones de
despojos en el lugar donde se
efectuó la catástrofe; el primero lo
forman los restos de la despeda-
zada caldera y trozos de rieles
arrancados de la vía; los otros
dos son más de hojas de acero,
doblado en caprichosas formas
irregularas. Estas hojas de acero,
de media pulgada de espesor, es-
tán dobladas y ajadas como si
fuera de péliz cartón.

UN CRIMINAL MONSTRUOSO.
Ultimamente se ha estado ven-
tiendo en la ciudad de Kansas
la causa de Dr. Hyde á quien
se acusa de varios asesinatos
tan pérpidos y tan desalmados
que bien se puede creer que no
podrían acontecer ni entre los
pueblos más barbáricos. Segun
aparece, este doctor en el ejer-
cio de su profesión, mató á sus
pacientes en lugar de curarlos, y
demostró claramente el grado
de barbarie á que puede conducir
un hombre que carece de mo-
ralidad y religión y que es inca-
paz de sentir remordimientos ni
alrigar escrúpulos de conciencia.
Es probable que aún cuando sea
convicto y hallado culpable de
los crímenes de que le acusan, lo
grará escaparse de todo castigo
y se burlará de la justicia huma-
na, del mismo modo que por me-
dio de sus actos se ha burlado
durante su vida de la justicia
divina.

EL PROF. DREWS Y LA VIDA DE JE- SUCRISTO.

"La controversia acerca de si
positivamente existió alguna vez
el Cristo bíblico, ha provocado
una notable demostración de la
fé Cristiana en Berlín.
El Domingo pasado, las princi-
pales agrupaciones protestantes,
arreglaron una grande demo-
stración en masa para protestar
contra las heréticas opiniones del
Prof. Drews. Horas antes de que
principiara la sesión, el Circo
Winter, donde tuvo lugar, estab-
a cercado por una multitud de
veinte mil hombres y mujeres que
a gritos pedía se les permitiera la
entrada, logrando escabullirse al
interior solamente 5,000 de ellos.
Los demás se reunieron en sesión
en las afueras del circo. Los pre-
dicadores, excitados sobre mane-
ra improvisaban arengas á las
turmas. Al concluir, la turba
multa se unió para cantar el fa-
moso himno de Lutero "Ein Fest-
te Burg Ist Unser Gott," y luego,
formando en procesión, marcha-
ron á través del río hacia la ca-
dral Real donde principiaron
un nuevo coro de himnos.
Tan pronto como se dió fin á
los servicios regulares, los mani-
festantes pidieron permiso á las
autoridades de la catedral, para
organizar un culto especial de
gracias, por la gráfica evidencia
de la firmeza de la fe, que evocaron
los eventos del día. Las au-
toridades lo concedieron. En me-
nos de cinco minutos se llenó hasta
el último rincón de la Abadía
Westminster, de Berlín, quedan-
do fuera diez mil fervidos creyentes.
El Capellán del Emperador, Dr.
Dryander, percorrió un elocuen-
te sermón, congratulando á la
Iglesia y dando gracias á Dios
por el frenético entusiasmo con
que la capital del imperio se unía
para rechazar las teorías de
Drews.

Dícese que los directores de los
templos se sorprendieron positi-
vamente ante la magnitud y fer-
vor de los manifestantes, y se
creen autorizados para estimar
el hecho como una conviniente
prueba de que el Cristianismo y
el temor en Diostintern rafeces pro-
fundas en los corazones de los
alegres habitantes de Berlín. Las
Autoridades religiosas juzgan
que esta demostración en una
piedra en la historia de la Iglesia
de Berlín, que perdurará y al-
canzará resultados en el lejano
porvenir.

LA NEMESIS DE LOS MALOS OFICIA- LES.

Diariamente vienen reportes de
varias de las ciudades popula-
res del oriente anunciando que
los abusos y malversaciones de
este ó quel oficial público han
salido á luz, á pesar de que mu-
chos años ha estado trinchera-
do en el puesto y que figuraba
en primera linea como hombre
de prominencia e influencia. Las
diferentes ofensas de que han si-
do culpables durante los tiempos
de su predominancia son muchas
y muy variadas y denotan que
la impunidad aunque dure mucho
no dura para siempre, y que por
fin se llega la hora y dia en que
tienen que pagarlas todas ju-
tas. Esto enseña que los malos
oficiales están expuestos á cada
momento á que se descubran sus
malos procederes para que su-
fran la vergüenza y el escarnio
que tan ricamente han merecido.

CHASCO REGULAR PARA MUCHOS.

No solamente en las grandes

cidades que gastan humos de
metropolitana en las regiones
más populosas de la Union, sino
también en los pequeños villorios
de Nuevo México que toman
el aire y el nombre de ciudades,
hay probabilidad de que el resul-
tado del censo salga muy atrás
de los reclamos que se hacen. En
esto no se perderá mucho y aún
se puede ganar algo desvane-
ciendo ilusiones y quimeras que
tenían embargado el ánimo de mu-
chos. Aunque indudablemente la
mayoría de las poblaciones y
plazas más populosas del Terri-
torio no mostrarán el aumento
anticipado, sin embargo, no cabe
duda que el conjunto de la popu-
lación en todo Nuevo México en-
señará mucho adelanto sobre el
censo de 1900. Esto está de
manifesto por el hecho de que el
Territorio ha crecido mucho du-
rante los diez años pasados, pu-
diendo como puede agregar á la
cifra de los habitantes los de mu-
chas poblaciones y comunidades
nuevas que no existían ni de
nombre cuando se tomó el otro
censo. A esto se puede agregar
el aumento natural en los condados
antiguos, que es regular en
todos ellos y considerable en al-
gunos. Teniendo esto en cuenta
hay razón para confiar en que el
total de población en el Terri-
torio será tal que durará satisfa-
cción plena en su resultado gene-
ral, aún cuando en lo particular
algún chasquedad algunas pla-
zas.

MERMA EN POPULACION.

Un diario de Santa Fé, de fecha
reciente, publica un artículo que
nos parece muy bien fundado res-
pecto á la merma en la popula-
ción hispano-americana que ha
ocurrido en aquella ciudad en los
años últimos. Atribuye esa cir-
cunstancia al gran número de
defunciones que casi uniforme-
mente ocurren cada invierno, las
cuales, dice, que exceden al nú-
mero de nacimientos, y también
á la circunstancia de que muchas
personas, en particular jóvenes,
se han ido á otros lugares donde
pueden ganar la vida con más
comodidad. Añade el citado artí-
culo que la población ameri-
cana en Santa Fé se ha dupli-
cado durante igual período de tie-
mo. No hay razón para dudar
de la exactitud de las opinio-
nes que emite sobre el asunto, y
esto se puede ver por lo que está
sucediendo en todas partes del
Territorio en ese mismo particu-
lar, lo cual viene á ser causa de
que la población hispano-ame-
ricaña no muestra aumento que
debería mostrar. En primer lu-
gar, cuando hacen treinta ó cuarenta
años se pobló Colorado, una
multitud de gente de la parte
septentrional del Territorio y
principalmente de los condados de
Río Arriba y Taos se fué á es-
tablecer allá causando una gran
merma en la población normal
de Nuevo México. Despues han
ocurrido epidemias periódicas de
viruela, difteria, fiebre escar-
tina y otras enfermedades que
han causado una mortandad es-
pantosa entre los niños. Aún
con tantas pérdidas la popula-
ción hispano-americana en el
Territorio ha tenido un aumento
regular, mas no tan grande
podría haber sido sin las grandes
rebajas de que hemos hecho
mención. No hay duda que es-
tas pérdidas podrían haber sido
evitadas con un poco de cuida-
do y atención adecuada á los
niños en sus enfermedades y por
medio de precauciones para evi-
tar que el contagio de las epidé-
mias se propague, pero esto no
se ha hecho en la mayoría de ca-
sos y las consecuencias han sido
funestas. Por lo que respecta á
Santa Fé y otras poblaciones del
Territorio, es muy natural y
hasta inevitable que cuando cre-
zca la población tengaque irse
mucho gente á otras partes por
no haber allí trabajos es industria-
rias para darles ocupación lu-
crativa. Sin embargo, en lo
general, ha habido aumento en
la población hispano-americana
y no hay razón para temer que
vaya á menos porque si unas lo-
calidades han tenido rebaja o
trabajos han tenido aumento, parti-
cularmente en regiones recién po-
bladas.

trioticos.

Ha muerto Mark Twain, el hu-
morista americano, cuyo mérito

teratos americanos. Sin embargo,
los peritos en literatura opini-
an que vale más un epitafio de
Cervantes que todas las obras
juntas de Mark Twain, y alegan
que este es muy inferior en
mérito á Dickens, Thackeray y
otros escritores ingleses.

La fecha que se señala para la
terminación del canal de Panamá
es el año de 1915, en cuya época
se propone celebrar una
gran exposición internacional en
San Diego California, que será
como el apogeo del regocijo inspi-
rado por la terminación de tan
grande obra.

Respecto á los buques arcos se
reportan muchas bazañas mar-
vilosas que diariamente están
haciendo caminando por los vi-
res, más también ocurren con
frecuencia desastres que demues-
tran que todavía falta mucho
para que el hombre pueda decir
con verdad que tiene el dominio
del aire.

Los ataques contra la tarifa
proteccionistas están muy en ra-
zón en ciertos puntos y muy fuer-
ta de ella en otros, pero al fin
traerán una rebaja radical que
disminuirá las ganancias de los
fabricantes y monopolistas y que
al mismo tiempo cerrará las fá-
bricas y manufacturas y dejará
sin ocupación á miles de hom-
bres en todas partes de los Esta-
dos Unidos.

Desde tiempos inmemoriales
los texanos han pretendido ejer-
cer una especie de soberanía so-
bre Nuevo México, y aun han tra-
tado varias veces de conquistar
el territorio por medio de las ar-
mas. A la fecha no han desisti-
do todavía de su pretención, pero
están empleando otros me-
dios menos ruidosos pero más
efectivos para establecer su do-
minación.

El Hon. Antonio Joseph fué un
hombre muy honrado, y como
representante de Nuevo México
en el Congreso jamás hizo trai-
ción á los intereses de sus consti-
tuyentes sino que les sirvió fiel-
mente y de buena fe durante los
diez años de su servicio congresional.
Este, y sus cualidades como ciudadano particular, con-
stituyeron su mejor título á la gra-
ta recordación del pueblo de Nue-
vo México.

Parce que el Presidente Taft
y su administrador general de
correos se proponen poner el ser-
vicio postal bajo las reglas del
servicio civil, resultando que los
estafeteros de tercera y cuarta
clase no podrán ser nombrados
sin haber pasado antes la debida
examinación. En cuanto á los
estafeteros de primera clase estos
serán inamovibles y no podrán
ser relevados del empleo mien-
tras presten buen servicio.

Ahora se está abogando con
mucha fuerza en pro de la ense-
ñanza manual en las escuelas pú-
blicas. Esto nos parecería muy
bien si se tratase de que tal ense-
ñanza fuese dada en escuelas de-
dicadas exclusivamente á tra-
bajos mensuales, pero en lo que to-
ca á las escuelas públicas no hay
duda que esa mezcla resultaría
en que los muchachos no apren-
diésemos á leer ni trabajar y en que
perdiésemos el tiempo, pues hay
un adagio que dice que quien mu-
chio abarca poco aprieta."

FASE NUEVA DE BRYAN.
Parce que el famoso agitador
William Jennings Bryan, después de
haber figurado de Demócrata,
Platista, Populista y Campeón
del Pueblo, ahora tiene en mira
el proyecto de ponerse al amparo
del Pabellón Prohibicionista y
hacer nueva campaña como can-
didato presidencial de una nueva
combinación que ostente como
piedra fundamental de su pro-
grama la prohibición absoluta
de la venta y fabricación de li-
quores embriagantes. No hay pa-
ra decir que es un nuevo ar-
did del astuto político para re-
nir bajo una sola bandera al
partido Demócrata, al Prohibi-
cionista y á todos las agrupaciones
dispersas que anden en
busca de nuevas alianzas y com-
binaciones. Es posible que si sus
máximos socios fueran Bryan podría
formar una agrupación formidable.

EL IMPERIO DEL LIBRO Y LA FA- TIGA DE LA MEMORIA

En el último congreso celebrado en
Clermont Ferrand, la Asociación
Francesa para el progreso de las ciencias
ha llamado especialmente la aten-
ción de dos trabajos, uno es el del
profesor Paul Appell, de la Sorbonne;
el otro del eminente químico y físico
inglés, Sir William Ramsay.

El profesor Appell ha elegido como
asunto de su trabajo, la enseñanza de
las ciencias y la formación de la que
puede llamarse espíritu científico.

Según este sabio, lo que se llama
enseñanza integral, esto es, la sistematización
de todos los conocimientos
humanos á fin de que los alumnos alcancen
éxitos brillantes tanto al obtener
el grado de bachiller, como
los diplomas universitarios adolecen
de Francia de gravísimos defectos puesto
que tiende á desarrollar y fatigar la
memoria y no á despertar la curiosidad
científica, el placer pura y desinteresado
de la investigación. Para el profesor
Appell, el "hombre ciencia" no es el
"hombre que sabe," sino el hombre
que á sus conocimientos suma la
actividad científica ó sea una curiosidad
infatigable y sobre todo iniciativa constante
en la investigación de la verdad.
Y la enseñanza en Francia no está
planteada en forma que desarrolle esas
aptitudes.

El sistema de exámenes tal como se
practica, constituye una prueba de memoria
del alumno no su afro, ni siquiera
un sondeo de los conocimientos
que poseen realmente frutos de observación
y la experiencia.

El mal se extiende desde las escuelas
de instrucción primaria hasta las
más altas escuelas especiales y es de
apremiente necesidad según M. Appell
el empezar á oponerse á esa tendencia.

La solución que propone el profesor
Appell consiste en reorganizar por
completitud las universidades cambiando
los métodos de enseñanza y en susti-
tuir los dos ó tres últimos cursos que
ahora pasan los liceos (institutos)
por curso especial de preparación para
entrar en una nueva clase de establecimiento
entre instituto y la universidad.
En estas nuevas escuelas se
enseñará á los alumnos á estudiar á
observar á experimentar, y, según el
trabajo que hagan durante todo el año,
no por quince minutos de preguntas y
respuestas, se podrán apreciar la capaci-
dad y aptitudes de los alumnos, elegirlos
los que han de seguir adelante en sus
estudios aun consejando la dirección que
deben tomar éstos, con más seguridad
de éxito.

LA ESCUELA.

Desde que la cultura logró emanar
de las trabas que durante siglos la
tuvieron infecunda y sujeta, encas-
tada en una sola inviable y mezquina
dirección, "la escuela" disputó el pri-
mer puesto en importancia, á los elem-
tos de prosperidad, trazos de los
cuales corrían los pueblos todos, acre-
tando unas veces y otras errando.

En la escuela, donde antaño se ins-
truía el niño á medias y violentando
en alguno ó algunos de los ramos del
saber humano establecidos por las
autoridades precedentes, el joven de
nuestros días aprende amplia, grata y
armónicamente, á conocer y explotar
sus propias aptitudes, á la vez que se
familiariza con los procedimientos de
sus antecesores, repitiéndolos y analizándolos
bajo la prudente dirección de un
sabio y experto guía.

En la escuela, donde antaño se ini-
ciaba el niño desde sus primeros y va-
cantes pasos, en las maravillas de lo
desconocido, antes que darse cuenta de
él mismo y de este misterio babilónico,
se ha invertido el programa, sabiamente
y después de iniciárselo en el mundo
conocible y fenomenal, se le prepara
para mayores, más amplias y abstractas
concepciones metafísicas.

pública es la más elevada función po-
lítica.
