Regular Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Otero County, New Mexico.

Be it remembered that at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Otero, New Mexico, held at the Court House in the Town of Alamogordo, on Monday, January 6th, 1913, at the hour of nine o'clock a. m., present and presiding D. M. Sutherland, Chairman, J. Emmett Gregg and J. J. Sanders, Commissioners, Chas. E. Thomas, Clerk, and J. V. Latham, Deputy Sheriff, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

On this day came on for consideration the matter of the designation of the official county paper, and after due consideration thereof and of the applications on file, it was ordered that the "Alamogordo News-Advertiser" be and the same is hereby selected and designated as the Official County paper of Otero County for the year 1913.

The following quarterly report on file before this board were audited and approved: Justice of Peace Precinct 13, report of 4th Quarter, 1912; J. W. Long, Justice of Peace Precinct 3, report of 4th Quarter, 1912; Y. P. Barnett, Justice of Peace Precinct 11, report of 4th Quarter, 1912; W. K. Siskup, Justice of Peace Precinct 1, report of 4th Quarter, 1912; C. E. Beasley, Justice of Peace Precinct 6, report of 4th Quarter, 1912; J. M. Poss, Justice of Peace Precinct 19, report of 4th Quarter, 1912.

The petitions for the establishment of a County High School to be located at Alamogordo, New Mexico, coming on now for hearing and it appearing to the Board that said petitions are in the form and in compliance with the requirements of Chapter 37 of the Laws of 1912; That the said County of Otero having a population of more than five thousand inhabitants as shown by the last Federal Census, is entitled under the said act to establish such a High School in the said County;

That the said petitions contain the names of more than one-third of the electors of the said County, including women qualified as provided in Section 1 of Article VII of the State Constitution; and the said petitioners requesting that an election be called by the Board to determine the question of establishing a County High School at Alamogordo, in the said County.

It is therefore ordered that an election be and hereby is called to be held on the 29th day of March, 1913, at the several precincts of Otero County to determine the question of establishing a County High School at Alamogordo, N. M., the said election to be conducted and returns made in the manner and form prescribed by law.

The resignation of James Brownfield, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 12 heretofore filed and accepted and the office of Justice of the Peace of said Precinct declared vacant.

On this day came on for hearing the petition of J. C. Jones asking for a franchise granting permission for the construction and operation of an electrical railway along and upon certain highways in the County of Otero, and after full consideration of same, together with the arguments in favor thereof by said J. C. Jones and his attorney, it was considered by the Board that granting of said franchise would be of great benefit to the community at large.

It was therefore ordered by the unanimous vote of the Board that said franchise be and the same is hereby approved and granted, said franchise to be in the following words and figures, to-wit: "WHEREAS, J. C. Jones has this day filed with the Board a petition asking for a franchise for an electric railway over and upon the streets within the County of Otero, State of New Mexico, after which the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"BE IT RESOLVED that the said J. C. Jones, and his successors, executors, administrators and assigns be and is hereby granted the right, privilege and franchise to construct, maintain and operate, for a term of fifty years from the date hereof, along and upon the roads and highways of the County of Otero, State of New Mexico, from the Town of Clouderoff in said County, down and through James Canon to the easterly line of the Town of Clouderoff in said County of Otero, down and through Cox Canon to the easterly line of said County of Otero, including all necessary tracks, side tracks, poles, wires, cross-arms, power houses, constructions and appurtenances necessary for constructing, maintaining and operating the same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators and assigns shall at all times maintain its line of railway in a first class manner and so as not to impede or interfere with the use of any of said roads and streets, highways or thoroughfares to the unreasonable interference with, or injury of any of the same as public thoroughfares. And this Board reserves the right to be the sole Judge of whether or not the provisions hereof have been complied with, and further, that the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators or assigns shall within eighteen months from the date hereof commence the construction of the operation of the said line of railway from the Town of Clouderoff, down and through James Canon to the easterly line of the said County of Otero, and from the town of Clouderoff down and through Cox Canon to the easterly line of said County of Otero;

AND PROVIDED FURTHER, that the grades and crossings of any such lines of railway, or the construction of any part of the same in any manner affecting the travel of the said streets or highways shall always be subject to the approval of this Board, and it is made the duty of the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators or assigns, prior to the construction of any of the street ways or appurtenances to the same, to submit to this Board a proposition in detail showing the route of said proposed railway and to especially show the grades relative to the streets and highways upon which the same shall be subject to the approval of this Board relative to the establishment of such grades and the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators or assigns, shall not construct any part of such line until the grade, location and survey of the same has been accepted and approved by this board.

It is hereby expressly provided that at any time during the continuance of this franchise the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators or assigns shall at all times keep in proper repair in keeping with the adjoining improvements all of such streets and highways so occupied by them, and the said line of railway within the rails and tracks thereof shall be so kept at all times.

The said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators, or assigns shall not at any time erect or permit to be erected anything whatever upon any of the said streets and highways, or upon any extension thereof, so as to interfere with the proper use of the same in any manner as public streets or highways.

This grant and franchise to take effect and be in full force from and after January 1, 1913.

Approved by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Otero, State of New Mexico, met at Alamogordo, at the hour of eight o'clock a. m., present and presiding D. M. Sutherland, Chairman, J. Emmett Gregg, J. J. Sanders, Commissioners, Chas. E. Thomas, Clerk, and J. V. Latham, Deputy Sheriff, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

That the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators or assigns shall at all times maintain its line of railway in a first class manner and so as not to impede or interfere with the use of any of said roads and streets, highways or thoroughfares to the unreasonable interference with, or injury of any of the same as public thoroughfares. And this Board reserves the right to be the sole Judge of whether or not the provisions hereof have been complied with, and further, that the said J. C. Jones, his successors, executors, administrators or assigns shall within eighteen months from the date hereof commence the construction of the operation of the said line of railway from the Town of Clouderoff, down and through James Canon to the easterly line of the said County of Otero, and from the town of Clouderoff down and through Cox Canon to the easterly line of said County of Otero;

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22 and part of Lot 23, Section 4, Township 16 S., Range 11 E., being 54 acres, for each of the years 1902, 1903, 1904, 1905, 1906, 1907, 1908, 1910, 1911 and 1912, making a total rebate of taxes amounting to \$34,887; and that he also be rebated all costs and penalties added to said taxes for the years specified above;

That a reduction of \$100.00 be granted Mrs. Navora Harrison on improvements on Lots Nos. 20 and 21 of Block No. 18, Alamogordo, N. M., said property being assessed for the year 1912 in the name of Mrs. Cynthia Grimes; said reduction being asked for the year of 1912.

That Mrs. Julia M. Blazer, of Tularosa, Precinct No. 3, be allowed an exemption of \$200.00 for the year 1912 on her homestead, to-wit: Lots A, B, C and D of Block No. 26, in the Town of Tularosa, N. M.; That P. J. Rennings, of Precinct No. 1 be rebated \$17.00 on the tax roll for 1912 on land on the Southwest quarter of Sec. 17, Twp. 17 S., R. 9 E., and that he be granted a rebate of \$317.00 on the assessed valuation of improvements upon said land for the year 1912 on account of over-assessment thereof;

That S. Melvin, of Precinct No. 10 be granted a rebate of \$100.00 on the tax roll of 1912 on improvements upon Lot No. 4 of Block 190 in the Town of Clouderoff, N. M., being the homestead of said applicant; That Mrs. Anna Herford, of Precinct No. 3 be granted a rebate of \$100.00 on the assessed valuation of stock assessed against her on the tax roll for the year 1912;

That Chas. Anderson, of Precinct No. 3 be granted a rebate of \$100.00 on the assessed valuation of improvements upon Lot 4 of Block 18 in the Town of Tularosa, N. M., for the year 1912 said assessment having been made from erroneous information;

That Mrs. Atascarga Gutierrez, of Precinct No. 3 be granted a rebate of \$139.00 on the assessed valuation of land on the tax roll for the year 1912 on account of erroneous classification of the land therein assessed;

That G. A. and W. A. Hyde, of Precinct No. 3, be granted a rebate of \$500.00 on the assessed valuation of personal property on the tax roll for the year 1912;

That Lee Wilkerson, of Precinct No. 7, be granted a rebate of \$1600.00 on the tax roll for the year 1912, on personal property on account of erroneous assessment;

That J. H. Fread, of Precinct No. 1, be granted an exemption of \$200.00 on the tax roll for the year 1912, said exemption to be applied on the taxes assessed against Lots Nos. 1 to 6 inclusive of Block No. 95 of the Town of Alamogordo, N. M., being the homestead of petitioner;

That Mrs. M. J. Hunter, of Precinct No. 1, be granted a reduction of \$250.00 upon the assessed valuation of improvements on Lot 2 of Block 20 in the Town of Alamogordo, N. M., on account of error in the rendition of said property by the owner thereof;

That George Davis, of Precinct No. 1, be allowed homestead exemption of \$200.00 for year 1912 on the Northeast quarter of Sec. 14, Twp. 17 S., R. 9 E., said land being the residence and home of the petitioner;

That Mrs. Lon Roberts, of Precinct No. 3, be allowed \$200.00 homestead exemption on the tax roll for the year 1912, said exemption to be allowed on Lot B of Block 35 of the Town of Tularosa, N. M., being the home of petitioner, in the matter of the petitions for tax corrections filed by J. R. Loomis and Mrs. S. E. Anglin applications therein contained were denied.

On this day came on for consideration the applications filed for the position of janitor and A. J. Messers was duly appointed as such janitor for the year 1913, his duties thereunder to commence on January 1st, 1913.

Annual report of Dr. J. G. Holmes, County Health Officer and Jail Physician, for the year 1912, received and approved.

The County Surveyor's plat of Russia Canon Road received and approved and ordered that same be referred to the County Road Board, together with the plat of proposed road from Weed, N. M., to the Chas. County Line, and road viewers report attached thereto.

It was ordered by the Board that the following transfers of county funds be made and the Treasurer and Collector instructed accordingly:

Transfer \$320.00 from Road District No. 1, to Special Road Fund.

Transfer \$912.11 from Delinquent Tax to General School Fund.

By order of the Board the Treasurer and Collector was given the authority to correct Tax Sale Certificate No. 323 by eliminating therefrom the North half of Lot A Block 35, Town of Tularosa, N. M., on account of error in assessment.
