Regular Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Otero County, New Mexico.

Be it remembered that at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Otero, New Mexico, held at the Court House in the Town of Alamogordo, on Monday, January 6th, 1913, at the hour of nine o'clock a.m., present and presiding D. M. Sutherland, Chairman, J. Emmett Gregg, and J. J. Sanders, Commissioners; Chas. E. Thomas, Clerk, and J. V. Latham, Deputy Sheriff, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

On this day came on for consideration the matter of the designation of the official county paper, and after due consideration thereof and of the applications on file, it was ordered that the "Alamogordo News-Advertiser" be and the same is hereby selected and designated as the Official County paper of Otero County for the year 1913.

The following quarterly reports on file before this board were adopted and approved:

W. L. Garrison, Justice of Peace Prec. 13, report of 4th Quarter, 1912. J. W. Long, Justice of Peace Prec. 3, report of 4th Quarter, 1912. Y. F. Barnes, Justice of Peace Prec. 11, report of 4th Quarter, 1912. W. K. Stalup, Justice of Peace Prec. 1, report of 4th Quarter, 1912. C. E. Beasley, Justice of Peace Prec. 6, report of 4th Quarter, 1912. J. M. Poss, Justice of Peace Prec. 10, report of 4th Quarter, 1912.

The petitions for the establishment of a County High School to be located at Alamogordo, New Mexico, coming on now for hearing and appearing to the Board that said petitions are in the form and in compliance with the requirements of Chapter 57 of the Laws of 1912;

The said County of Otero having a population of more than five thousand inhabitants as shown by the last Federal Census, is entitled under the said act to establish such a High School in the said County;

That the said petitions contain the names of more than one-fifth of the electors of the said County, including women qualified as provided in Section 1 of Article VII of the State Constitution; and the said petitioners requesting that an election be called by the Board to determine the question of establishing a County High School at Alamogordo, in the said County.

It is therefore ordered that an election be and hereby is called to be held on the 23rd day of March, 1913, within the several precincts of Otero County to determine the question of establishing a County High School at Alamogordo, N. M., the said election to be conducted and returns made in the manner and form prescribed by law.

The resignation of James Brownfield, Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 12 heretofore filed was accepted and the office of Justice of the Peace of said Precinct declared vacant.

On this day came on for hearing the petition of J. C. Jones asking for a franchise granting permission for the construction and operation of an electrical railway along and upon certain highways in the County of Otero, and, after full consideration of same, together with the arguments in favor thereof by said J. C. Jones and his attorney, it was considered by the Board that granting of said franchise would be of great benefit to the community at large.

It was therefore ordered by the unanimous vote of the Board that said franchise be and the same is hereby approved and granted, said franchise being in the following words and figures, to-wit:

This grant and franchise to take effect and be in full force from and after January, 1913.

Approved by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Otero, State of New Mexico, in regular session this the 6th day of January, A. D. 1913.

Tuesday, January 7th, 1913.

Pursuant to adjournment of the Board of County Commissioners of Otero County, New Mexico, met at the Court House in the Town of Alamogordo, at the hour of eight o'clock A. M., present and presiding the same officers and members as of yesterday, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the various tax correction petitions filed and brought before the Board, and after due consideration thereof: Resolved by the Board, that said matters be referred to the Honorable District Attorney for his consideration, with the recommendation that an order of the District Court be had granting the following corrections, and the Treasurer and Collector of Otero County directed to correct his tax rolls in accordance therewith to-wit:

That on the showing made before the Board as to valuation and existing conditions, E. J. Martin, be rebated the sum of \$9,488 on taxes assessed against him on Lots

22 and part of Lot 23, Section 4, Township 16 S., Range 11 E., being 54 acres, for each of the years 1902, 1903, 1904, 1905, 1906, 1907, 1908, 1910, 1911 and 1912, making a total rebate of taxes amounting to \$9,488; and that he also be rebated all costs and penalties added to said taxes for the years specified above;

That a reduction of \$100.00 be granted Mrs. Navora Harrison on improvements on Lots Nos. 20 and 21 of Block No. 18, Alamogordo, N. M., said property being assessed for the year 1912 in the name of Mrs. Cynthia Grimes; said reduction being asked for the year of 1912.

That Mrs. Julia M. Blazer, of Tularosa, Precinct No. 3, be allowed an exemption of \$200.00 for the year 1912 on her homestead, to-wit: Lots A, B, C, and D, of Block No. 26, in the Town of Tularosa, N. M.
