





The United States Geological Surcey has recently issued a special map

formed by combining a number of topographic sheets, previously pub-liahed, of the country surrounding Norfolk, Virginia. The section covered by the new map, known as the Norfolk quadrangle, includes Fort Monroe, Newport News, Hampton Roads, Norfolk and Portsmouth and extends for about four miles south of the North Carolina line; it also covers a large area of the Dismal Swamp.

A striking peculiarity of the Dismai Swamp is clearly brought out by the map, which shows that the surface of the swamp stands from seven to ten feet higher than the surrounding country, and the unusual phenomenon of streams draining out of it in all direc-tions is observed.
