WHAT DO YOU KNOW?

About SIERRA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, and Its Mines of GOLD and SILVER, COPPER, LEAD, IRON and COAL.—CATTLE, SHEEP and AGRICULTURAL INTERESTS.

The Advocate is constantly receiving from all parts of the country, letters asking the above and following questions. To answer correspondents, to give reliable, accurate and authentic information, and to further advance our great interests, is the object of this article:

Is gold found at Hillsboro in quartz veins or in placers? In both, but principally in fissure veins. Between two and three hundred claims have been located on these veins which show pay ore at the surface and the work done on these varies from mere assessment holes to the principal mines that have been developed to a depth of 500 feet. What is the nature of the ore? Copper and iron sulphide and some comparatively free milling quartz. With depth the ore becomes smelting and concentrating material. The percentage of copper in the ore shipped to the smelters is from one to twelve units—in concentrates sometimes as high as twenty units. Silica in crude ore from forty to eighty-five. Smelter certificates show the ore to carry from two to fourteen ounces of gold, from three to sixty ounces silver. The bulk of the ore and concentrates shipped, however, will average about \$70 per ton.

Has there been any large production? The Opportunity group has produced 25,000 tons of ore and over half a million dollars. The Bonanza mine 7,000 tons and \$200,000. The Richmond 5,000 tons and over \$200,000. These are the largest producers so far. Are the milling facilities good? Practically they are not—the saving has been from fifty to seventy-five per cent, at the best. A modern custom mill is badly needed and a fortune awaits the parties who will build one. Sufficient water and an ideal concentrating ore, with proper appliances fitted to ninety-five per cent, would be the saving.

Will the owners let go easy, or do they want the earth? They are reasonable people, but they are not giving away their mines, or giving bonds on long-time rainbows. During the past two years some thirty mines have been sold, mostly around Aminta Peak, and the highest price paid was \$17,000. That mine was the largest producing and the best paying in the district and the owners would now ask a very large sum. The greatly improved price of copper and lower smelting rates have of late been very beneficial to these mines. With a good custom mill the progress would be rapid.

What are ore prospects? From the mine to the El Paso smelter from \$3 to \$7 per ton; from mine to mill 75 cents to \$1.50 per ton.

What is the geological formation? An eruptive country rock, by the experts classed as Andesite; the ore veins are found accompanying dikes of the granitic felsite and biotite porphyry which cut through the country northeast and southwest. Most of the veins are fairly easy working, on drift contracts prices have been from \$3 to \$9 per foot. Incline shafts on veins are cheaply driven, but vertical shafts in country rock have generally been found very expensive.

Is there much snow in winter? Not enough to snow by; the climate, winter and summer, is, from a miner's point of view, perfect. No snowslides and no pneumonia for the miner to dread.

Is there much placer mining? There is an extensive placer field which is open to locators and there are always some men at work who make from \$1 to \$5 per day. An occasional nugget brings up the average. Of course some men are luckier than others, here as elsewhere. Most of the gold is found within a few feet of the surface. The miners scoop up the pay streak dirt and run it through dry washing machines. The nearest water is distant five miles and about 400 feet below the gold level. Several companies have been formed to work these placers on a high scale, but the immense cost of bringing in sufficient water has made the project appear of doubtful profit. A new company has recently been organized to exploit this field with a machine of the Bucyrus type—this is probably the very best method and likely to succeed.

What is your estimate of the total output of the Hillsboro mines, all kinds, in dollars? Between two and two and a quarter millions.

Has anyone made big money at mining in Sierra county? In the Kingston district the Lady Franklin, Black Colt, Bullion, Superior, Comstock, Caledonia, Kangaroo, Brush Hen, Illinois, Templar, Virginia, Keystone, Cumberland, Gray Eagle and a few other properties had up to 1893 made an output of over eight million ounces of silver, sold at an average price of 43 cents per ounce. All of these mines made large profits, from twenty per cent, on the Gray Eagle to eighty and ninety per cent, on the Lady Franklin and others. At Lake Valley from only three claims there was mined in the space of a few years and with very great profit—over \$1,000,000. At Hermosa and at Chiricahua there was also some very profitable silver mining. No great fortunes have been made yet in the gold districts, but from the Placers and the Trippe, Richmond and Snake mines very respectable sums have been made by losses.

Is the decline in silver output due to the decline in silver, or to the exhaustion of the ore bodies? The very rich ore bodies, so far as known, have been practically exhausted, and the search for more is greatly discouraged. The decline in silver operates against the medium grades and the want of proper reduction works prevents the profitable working of the inexhaustible bodies of low grade ores. The experiments made in concentration have not been thorough enough, neither Wilcoys, vanners or jigs are by themselves sufficient. In a modern mill the ore goes through a series of processes and each process will save from forty to sixty per cent, of the value in the pulp that comes to it, so that the tailings finally flow off with a trifling loss. In this field there is a fine opening and a certain profit for the investment of capital.

Is the mineral field thoroughly explored, or is there still a chance for intelligent prospectors? There are hundreds of square miles in the mineral belt yet unexplored. It is not likely that the first wave of prospectors found all the treasures that nature has stored in the hills. The great deposits of silver chlorides and sulphides found in the Bridal Chamber at Lake Valley and in several Kingston mines have their counterparts waiting for the lucky man, but the hills, like the Scriptures, must be intelligently searched before they give up their treasures. The prospector can work all the year; if anything, perhaps better in winter time. Many of the mines, also, are open to leasing and the chances of this striking rich deposits are worth consideration. Long time and very liberal leases are the rule.

What about the recent discoveries reported of rich gold and silver tellurium ores? They are found so far on one claim on Trujillo creek, about six miles south of Kingston. Between \$200,000 and \$300,000 has already been realized on sale of ore. All this has been in small bunches of ore close to the surface. Quite a number of miners and prospectors are going into this new field. The section had been entirely ignored and beyond a little assessment work, nothing was done there. Now, with ore showing worth thousands of dollars per ton, it is likely to be heard of around the world. On Terra Blanca creek, not far from these new discoveries, are a number of good mines, notably the Log Cabin, a steady producer of good ore which brings from \$100 to \$300 per ton.

What copper and lead mines and deposits are there in Sierra county? Near Chiricahua, in the northern part of the county, there are mines of high grade copper ore, which are also rich in silver, from five to sixty per cent, copper and up to 1,500 ounces of silver per ton. The Silver Monument of this group has produced something over \$100,000. These mines also carry good gold values, including the Columbus. Recent developments on the Hooper Boy at Chiricahua, have disclosed a fine continuous vein of gold bearing ore some of which assays fourteen ounces

gold per ton. The Nana is making a good showing of ore, special values going forty ounces gold per ton. The Tunnel mine is a shipper of ore with a value of silver 205 ounces, copper twenty-two per cent, gold \$7.50. The May, also in the same district, is a good producer of high-grade silver-copper ore of the hornite variety. There is a revival of interest in this district and some good prizes will be heard from during the year is the U. S. Treasury. In the Cochillo range, a few miles to the east of Chiricahua, there are lime-shale contact deposits of lead carbonate and galena, also of copper pyrites, and there are possibilities of very great rewards for small investments in this direction. At Hermosa, between Hillsboro and Chiricahua, there is one of the most steadily productive mining camps in New Mexico; small as yet, but with a great future. At Kingston, the surface has been well prospected for silver deposits and over \$1,000,000 has been secured. Systematic development and proper reduction works for the utilization of lower grade ores are now needed. The low-grade ores are especially noticeable and there are great masses of such ore in sight in many of the mines. Copper and lead ores are found in great quantity in the Caballos, east of the Rio Grande, and about fifteen miles from Hillsboro. Carbon shipments of twenty per cent, copper ore, carrying also gold and silver, are becoming quite numerous and increasing. The ore is found in both fissure and contact veins and there is a large field still only partially prospected. Some very large veins of lead-silver ore—forty to fifty feet wide—and averaging over five per cent, lead ore are being investigated. A Kansas City company is now at work and building a mill for one of these groups. Lead ore is also found in richer condition, solid galena boulders of great size are quite common and indicate the possibility of great deposits in the contact veins. Not far from these ore deposits there are large and extensive veins of coal of fine quality. These mines and deposits have been known to exist for some years, but it is only lately that any real attention has been paid them. It looks now as if the Caballos will become the foremost mining section of the county. The new owners of the Arroyo Grande grant, which includes a portion of the coal and mineral lands, are going in for a liberal system of lease or sale of their property, and they will extensively advertise their inducements. All of this district is within a few miles of the A. T. & S. F. main line railroad, with a freight charge of about \$2 per ton to the El Paso smelter. No better market for ore than El Paso can be got at present, as the smelter there meets all rates offered from more distant points, and the great saving in time is much to the advantage of the miner. Other promising fields with extensive deposits of lead ore suitable for concentration are found in the Carpenter district, six miles southwest of Kingston, and on the Machio, a few miles south of Lake Valley.

Are there any good lands still open to settlement? Fully 25,000 acres of first and second bottom lands on the Rio Grande and its tributary streams. All of the lands are susceptible of irrigation by reasonable money investment or by community ditches and canals. What crops are raised? All kinds of fruit, grain and vegetables; everything that will grow in southern Kansas and Oklahoma will grow here. The southern latitude is mitigated by the altitude, which is 4,500 feet on the Rio Grande to between 5,000 and 6,000 feet above sea level on the mountain streams. The supply of water from the river is ample and in the valleys enough can be obtained with a little engineering. What market is there for farm produce? There is a good local market in the mining camps for very much more than has yet been produced. As regular prices we can quote: Alfalfa, \$20 per ton; corn, \$1 to \$1.50 per bushel; potatoes, \$2 to \$3 per 100 pounds; apples, \$5 per barrel. Are the cattle ranges fully occupied? West of the Rio Grande the range is pretty well stocked, but east of the river there is an extensive range, well grassed, that needs only the digging of wells and necessary pumping apparatus. Water beneath the surface there is plenty, as proved by the railroad wells.

Is the country suitable for raising fine sheep and goats? There are quite a number of people already who claim

to be profitably engaged in this business, and there is undoubtedly room for more.

RECENT MINING DISCOVERIES AND IMPROVEMENTS.

The most notable event at this writing at Hillsboro is the opening up of the large vein of rich gold ore on the 425-foot level of the Snake mine. In the levels above the foot wall had been followed, whereas this ore goes off to the hanging wall, it was lost. Its present discovery makes practically a new mine of the Snake and insures a large production for a long time to come. Experts estimate at from \$150,000 to \$300,000 on the ground already known. The ore is about one-fourth first-class \$75 to \$100 per ton, and the remainder milling an ounce and over per ton in gold. On the same vein, further north in the Hobtail ground, the lessees have got into a bonanza and will make a fortune therefrom. From the El Oro, the Philadelphia Smelting & Milling Company are now holding very rich ore, and enough of it to keep the mill in full swing. The Prosper mine, in the same vicinity, is also doing well and beginning to show a reward for the development of the past year. In the Tierra Blanca district there is an important discovery of lead carbonate ore of great promise. In the northern districts a number of good strikes, both in old and new properties, are reported. The immensely rich gold ores found in the Ivanhoe and Emporia mines, and also in the Great Republic group at Grafton, are warrant enough for further search in that direction. A New York company has been organized and incorporated for the purchase and operation of the Hillsboro mines, among which the Scandia group purchase is completed and short-time options are held on the Garfield, McKinley and others. The Weeks mine company's capital has been enlarged, a new manager appointed and active development will soon be in order. So many favorable indices of substantial progress encourage the belief that with the new century Sierra county is entering an era of advance and prosperity commensurate with its immense and varied mineral resources.

According to a convention between New Zealand and Venezuela and the United States a parcels post system became operative the other day between this country and the other two named. Altogether, provisions have been made for the parcels post service between the United States and five other countries. They are now in operation and are working satisfactorily.

The countries with which these agreements have been made are Great Britain, Germany, Guatemala, Venezuela and New Zealand. Other countries are anxious to enter into similar agreements, and it is believed that before the expiration of this year a number of others will be drawn and ratified by the legislative bodies of the countries interested. Since the United States entered into the treaty with Germany many other countries have been clamoring for a parcels post system with the United States. This system permits the mailing of a parcel weighing not more than 11 pounds to be delivered at the door of the person to whom it is addressed.

There has been considerable outcry on the part of the people in this country because congress has not provided for a domestic parcels post. Owing to the lack of this service foreigners have the advantage of the people of the United States, as the former can mail packages to be delivered anywhere in this country, while this privilege is denied to those living in the United States. On the other hand, there are many persons who do not favor a domestic parcels post. They contend the establishment of a service of this kind would mean the ruin of business concerns in the small towns, as the department stores in the cities would be enabled to command the business of the country. In addition to this the express companies are bitterly fighting the system, as it would make serious inroads into their business. There are no indications of congress enacting legislation providing for a domestic parcels post at this session.

A Patience Bee.
A small stingless bee is found in the state of Sinaloa and in Tepic. The honey of these bees is not great in quantity, is dark colored, very liquid and is said not to crystallize. Another peculiarity of the honey is that it has a decidedly sour or tart taste, and on this account it is much sought after as being a greater delicacy than the sweet honey of the same bee. The reason these bees are small producers is that, as they are stingless, they are constantly robbed by the larger varieties, the same bee being one of the robbers.

Grand Jury Report.

To the Hon. Frank W. Parker, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the Territory of New Mexico and Judge of the Third Judicial District thereof.

We, the Grand Jury of the June term A. D. 1901, having concluded our duty as such respectfully submit our final report to your honor.

GUARD THE ROYAL JEWELS.

When They Are Not in Pawn the Valuables of Monarchs Are Closely Watched.

Royal people are much given to the accumulation of jewels of great price, and they take especial care that these baubles are not stolen. Many of the so-called "crown jewels" which are shown to visitors to the Tower of London are "paste," the real gems being secured in strong vaults in iron-bound boxes. The jewels of the Russian imperial family form one of the most valuable collections in the world. This collection is guarded in a fortified castle watched over by a special detail of 150 retired officers and a body of soldiers. For this service they are well paid. No officer who in his days of active service was addicted to gambling or to extravagance can ever hope to be selected as one of the custodians of the imperial jewels. The czar keeps a portion of his own private jewels in banks in London and Paris, so that in case a revolution should break out in St. Petersburg he would have an "anchor to windward" in the two foreign capitals.

The treasures of the royal family of Italy are hidden away in deep vaults beneath a fort situated on a little island in the Tiber. Protected by the old and muddy stream overhead and the military on the island, the jewels are beyond the dreams of even the most daring and sanguine of burglars.

The prince of Bulgaria is possessed of precious stones to the value of \$5,000,000. These he keeps locked in a little castle on the banks of the Danube. King Milan of Serbia kept such of his jewels as are not in pawn in London and Paris banks. A ruby necklace belonging to the king is said to be in pawn for \$100,000. Some of the jewels belonging to the German imperial family are kept in London banks like those of the czar.

WEIGHTS BY A NEW SYSTEM.

A Unique Decimal Plan Devised by a Civil Engineer of Cleveland.

A new system of weights and measures has been devised for English-speaking people by A. L. Hyde, a civil engineer of Cleveland, O. It is a decimal system, with an inch as the basis. He calls it the Indick system. The inch becomes the 10, ten inches are an 10, 100 inches are an 1k and 1,000 inches are an 1l. In surface measurement the square inch is a squin, 100 square inches a squid, and the squik and squil are used to represent larger areas. To represent terms of capacity he uses the terms cubin, cubid and cubil. The terms for weight are an, ad, ak and al. An an is the weight of one cubic inch of water, the ad is the weight of ten cubic inches, and so on.

SPEEDY TRIP OF A BALLOON.

This One Went One Hundred Miles in Seventy-Five Minutes and Beat the Record. It seems incredible, yet it is a fact, that in Germany a few days ago a balloon traveled 100 miles in 75 minutes. The balloon left Strasburg at 11 a. m. and arrived at Hiberach at 12:15 p. m., being stopped there by the branch of a linden tree, which held it fast. When it was examined a note was found saying that it had left Strasburg at 11 a. m. of that day, and that any information as to its subsequent movements would be gratefully received by the Strasburg authorities. The news of its safe arrival at Hiberach, 100 miles distant from Strasburg, was at once sent to them, and on the following day Prof. Dr. Hergesell arrived from Strasburg and took charge of the balloon.

According to him, the first intention of himself and his colleagues was to send out a regular balloon with one or two passengers, but on account of the storm they were unable to do so. They then tried to send out a large balloon fitted with a barometer and other instruments, but the storm prevented it from making any headway, and so finally they equipped a small balloon with instruments and sent it forth.

One of the instruments, a barometer combined with a thermometer, showed that the balloon had attained a height of 7,000 meters, and another indicated that the lowest temperature which it had met was 25 degrees Reaumur. The balloon was made of varnished paper and was filled with coal gas. A basket hung from it, and in order to shield the sensitive instruments from the rays of the sun it was covered with silver paper.

ANDREE'S WILL OPENED.

The Explorer Had a Presentiment That His Journey Would Prove Fatal.

The Berlin correspondent of the London Standard says that Andree before starting on his balloon voyage for the north pole enjoined that his will should not be opened until the end of 1900. It was enclosed in a packet which was opened a few days ago in the presence of relatives. Some of the documents in the packet were sealed and inscribed "To be burnt unread." In addition to these there was a series of letters from scientists encouraging the expedition, and one from his friend Fourville warning him against the proposed trip. This was indorsed: "Possibly he is right; but it is now too late to withdraw."

The will is very short. The opening paragraph includes the following: "My presentiment tells me that this terrible journey will signify my death." The testator's small fortune of a few thousand marks is divided between his brother and sister. He bequeaths his large library of scientific works to his brother on condition that he in turn bequeath it to a public library.
