What the New Company Proposes to Charge for Water.

As the new canal enterprise, now under way, is attracting considerable attention, and many fears seem to exist among the people, we desire to clearly define the company's policy which we have been unable to do previously.

For a perpetual right to use water from our canals we will charge \$10 per acre, payable in five annual installments of \$2 each.

To acquire the right to purchase water in our canal on or before July 1st, 1897 we will make the price \$4 per acre.

The time of paying for water rights under a new canal, when such are already acquired, may seem at first thought somewhat objectionable.

Outside charging only for land, that is irrigated, the company constructs and maintains the canal.

The total cost of water for his 10 cultivated acres is \$7.50 per acre. At this rate in 5 years he will have paid in water charges \$37.50.

And the 8th and every subsequent year only \$15 as against \$72. This is an exceptional case and the fact is that many of our farmers from their own experience.

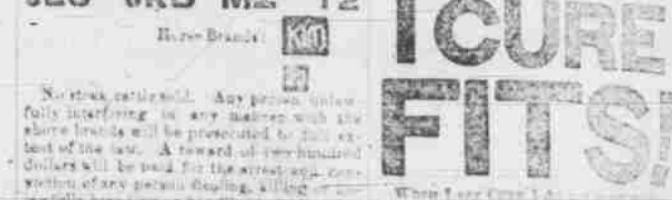
