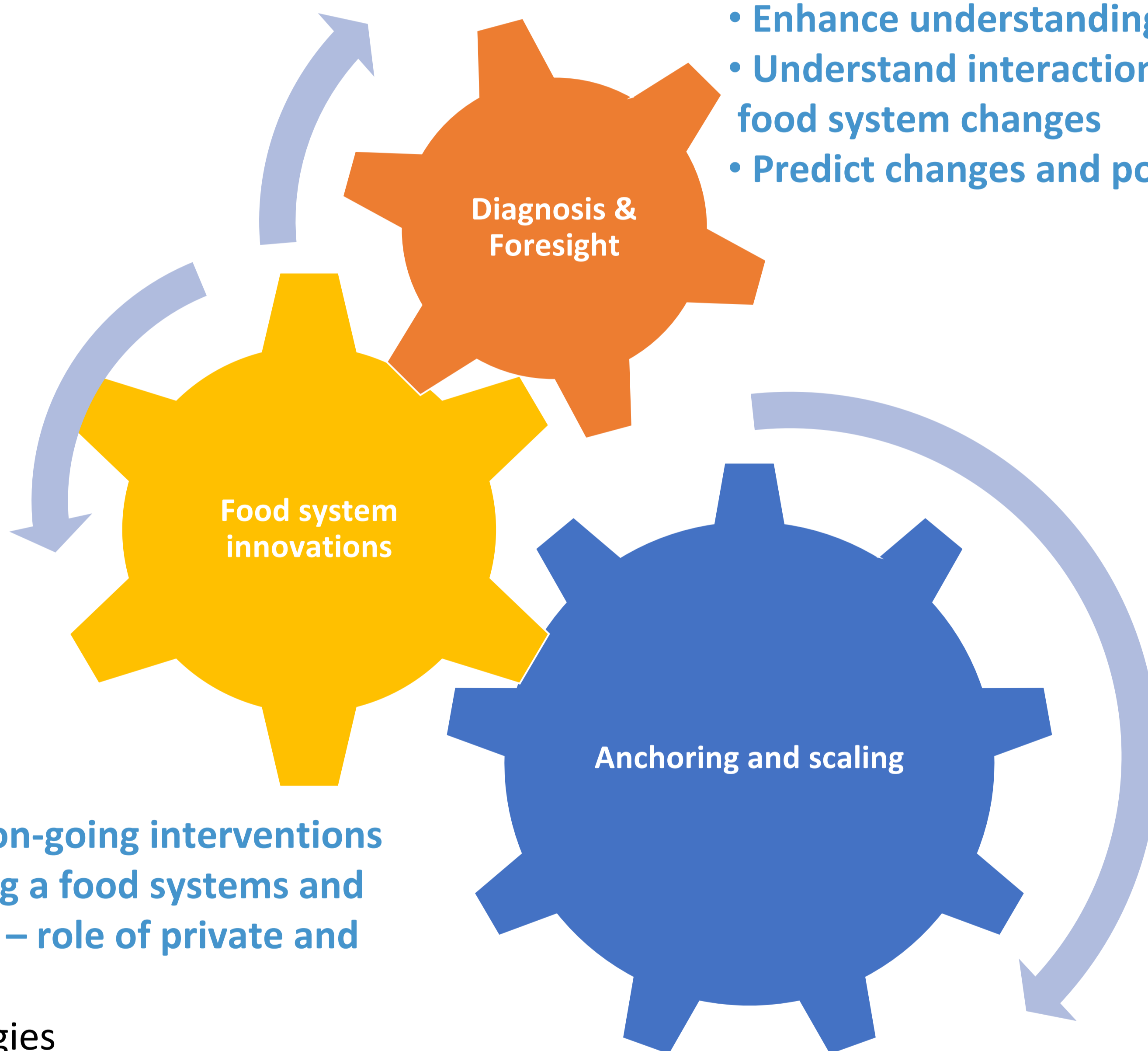




Food systems research in Ethiopia: 25 priority questions identified

- Tradeoffs and synergies
- Design and test implementation models that foster food system innovations that sustainably enhance diet quality

- Enhance capacity for food systems approaches and research
- Identify entry points for transitions to scale
- Engage multistakeholder platforms
