

**Search tools:** Basic or advanced searches of text, categories, and tags.  
**Display:** Formatted text, color, unicode fonts, images, citation, table of contents, synchronized translations and footnotes, and zoom.




**Study tools:** Searchable user notes, highlighting, and categories. Bookmarks, hyperlinks, dictionaries, PDFs, topics, copy and paste. Synchronized versions, translations, footnotes, or commentaries.

Other apps and online resources may lack helpful tools, tags, markup, formatting, multilingual support, speed, or data.


One linguist used online data to create a 700 million-word WordCruncher corpus. He said, "I couldn't have done a lot of my research with what is out there."

**Other analysis tools:** Repeated phrases (N-grams), word dispersion chart, vocabulary comparison of sections, paired collocations, normalized results, sort columns, and word or character usage.
