

### The Neoliberal University

"a theory of political economic practices that proposes that human well-being can best be advanced by liberating individual entrepreneurial freedoms and skills within an institutional framework characterized by strong private property rights, free markets, and free trade." (Harvey, *A Brief History of Neoliberalism*, 64).

"While personal and individual freedom in the marketplace is guaranteed. Each individual is held responsible and accountable for his or her own actions and well-being. This principle extends into the realms of welfare, education, health care, and even pensions" (65)

## Medieval Institutions under Capitalism



- The dissertation has existed in pretty much the same structure since the Medieval period.
- Exists in an uncomfortable position within the neoliberal university.
- Represents specialization and achievement of scholarly autonomy, but are there other ways to measure this?
- How does the combination of low job prospects sync with the amount of time to write and complete a dissertation (around 9 years for some programs).



## Challenges of Implementing Alternative Theses

- Academic jobs still privilege the "book" and so do hiring committees
  - Students should be clear about their priorities.
  - Students who want more traditional academic jobs may want to work on hybrid dissertations and theses.
- Tenure cases typically require a book, which comes from the diss.
  - Part of this conversation requires renovating academic as an entire ecosystem.
- Projects require different skills than dissertations.
  - Students should have some skills before setting out.
  - Advisors should be careful about student projects.
- Difficult for dissertation committees to advise and evaluate.
  - Faculty in humanities/social sciences usually don't have the skills to evaluate student projects.
  - Digital Humanities librarians can help here.
- Storage and maintenance of projects.
