Inclusive Design and Dissemination in Digital Scholarly Editing:

Survey Questions

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Justification

In 2017, the authors designed a survey titled *Inclusive Design and Dissemination in Digital Scholarly Editions*. The survey was designed and hosted using SurveyMonkey,¹ and was open from 1 July to 31 November 2017. The survey received 219 responses, 109 of which completed every required question in the survey – resulting in a completion rate of 49,7%.

At the 2017 ADHO conference in Montreal (Canada), the authors participated in a panel discussion on the subject, where they discussed some preliminary survey results (Sichani et al. 2017). A more detailed treatment of the complete survey results will be published in issue 14 of *Variants*,² the Open Access journal of the European Society for Textual Scholarship³ (Martinez et al. forthcoming).

In view of this publication, the authors have deposited the survey results as data sets in the Humanities Commons repository.⁴ These include a CSV file of the survey's data (scrubbed of respondents' personal information), and the current PDF with graphical representations of the survey's statistics. Both files present the survey's raw, uncorrected (albeit redacted) data, as recorded and automatically analyzed by SurveyMonkey. This includes response rates per question, and simple diagrams for quantitative survey questions.

As the uncorrected survey results, some of the data offered in these files may differ slightly from those presented in the forthcoming *Variants* article. For their qualitative analysis of the survey's data in that publication, the authors have corrected the data (e.g. excluding invalid answers, or reclassifying incorrectly classified answers), and interpreted them (e.g. creating categories for similar responses). Such interventions were explained and justified more elaborately in the relevant sections of the *Variants* article. Rather than depositing the corrected version of the survey's results in the Humanities Commons repository, however, the authors decided to publish the uncorrected results instead, so as not to force their interpretation of the survey's data on future research.











In what capacity are you familiar with the software/tools developed in your editing project(s)? Please choose all that apply.











Does your institution require that digital scholarly content (such as DSEs or their affiliated outputs) adhere to accessibility guidelines?








