
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## P-254: Health improvement & health promotion education of undergraduate radiographers in a Scottish HEI



Raise the issue [5] - encourage patients.




### **Research Question**

- Academics


regarding health promotion / health improvement education?

Students were generally much more positive about their experiences of health promotion / health improvement than academic staff. They had many examples from practice placements and envisioned clear goals regarding their role improving health for the future population.
