

Context




Aim

The present study aims at identify and analyze the metalinguistic skills in the process of collaborative creation of four stories by a pair of newly literate students.

Procedure of the study

This study is based on the empirical material collected by the International Cooperation Project InterWriting and PROTEXTOS: the interaction of the dyad while producing the stories was filmed and later transcripted as well as the writing movements (handspy).



Analysis categories


Metalinguistic review operations	
Fabre-Cols (2002)	
Suppression	Delete / delete a certain term without replacing it
Replacement	Suppression followed by an addition
Displacement	Changing the order of elements
Addition	Adding an element

Graf. 2 Number of metalinguistic revision operations performed for each text.





Gráfico. 3 . Number of oral comments produced in textual productions



Conclusion

- Replacement is the most relevant operation.
- Increased metalinguistic review operations throughout the various texts.
- Throughout the production of the four texts, the students of the dyad acquired a greater knowledge and mastery over writing, which in turn implies a higher level of metalinguistic awareness.
- Greater dominance of orthographic erasure (relating to the learning content of this reading and writing learning phase).
- The student responsible for the handwriting reveals a greater focus on spelling, while the other student who is formulating the text out loud might be more concerne about the organization of the stories.
