- In 2020, the opioid industry is predicted to have a market size of 18.4 billion dollars (Grandview Research).
- 70,237 opioid related deaths and national emergency declaration (FDA)
- 92 billion MMEs were sold in 2000, but 250 billion MMEs were sold in 2010 (CBS)
- 45 states have taken legal action against opioid producers and distributors (CBS)
- The CDC estimates the total economic burden of prescription opioid misuse in the US is \$78.5 billion a year (NCBI)
- The United States has the largest amount of opioid prescriptions in the world (CFR)
