


Cyber Chronix is a game raising awareness on privacy risks and data protection rights in the new European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

PERSONAL DATA

Personal data is any data that can be traced back to a particular person. It might be of course a name and a surname but also a piece of written information, a picture, a video, or even a sound recording if it is related to a person. It could be a telephone number, an email account, or somebody's shopping list, as long as these can be linked to a specific individual.

There are some types of personal data that are particularly sensitive and they refer people's political or religious beliefs, their heath, their ethnic origin, their sex life or biometric and genetic data. These types of data are especially protected by European Union (EU) General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Biometric and genetic data are particularly sensitive data as they are directly related to the human body, which means they are as such specific to each person and therefore particularly identifiable.



RIGHT TO DATA PROTECTION

The Right to the protection of personal data is recognised as a fundamental right by the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union.

In this purpose, the European Union (EU) General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) regulates the personal data processing by individuals, companies and organisations who wish to gather or use other people's personal data.





RIGHT TO BE INFORMED

Before any organisations starts collecting your personal data, you have the Right to be informed about who they are, what they are going to use their data for, and how.

The information must be provided to you in a concise, transparent, clear and plain language, particularly if addressed to a child.





RIGHT OF ACCESS

Individuals have the Right to request access to their personal data and supplementary information.

This Right allows individuals to be aware of and verify the lawfulness of the processing.





RIGHT TO RECTIFICATION

You have the Right to have your personal data corrected if it is inaccurate or incomplete.

Organisations should respond to your request within one month.

RIGHT TO DATA ERASURE/TO BE FORGOTTEN

The Right to erasure is also known as the Right to be forgotten. You have the right to obtain the erasure of your personal data where, the data are inadequate, no longer relevant, unlawfully processed or you withdraw consent.

Moreover, the right to be forgotten enables the delisting of data that affects your privacy negatively; in practical search engine operators must comply with requests to de-index information if it is inaccurate, out-of-date or goes against your interests in certain circumstances.



RIGHT TO DATA PORTABILITY

This right means two things.

- a) you have the Right to obtain electronically the information which is held about you by an organisation
- b) you have the Right to request for the data to be copied or transferred to another organisation





RIGHT TO OBJECT

You have the Right to object to the processing of your personal data and ask a company/organisation to stop processing your personal data if those are processed for example for direct marketing (including profiling).





RIGHTS RELATED TO AUTOMATED DECISION MAKING

You have the Right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated means without any human intervention.

This right applies to all automated decision making.

Profiling refers to the automated processing of personal data intended to evaluate, analyse, or predict aspects concerning your preferences, interests, behaviors, etc.

Individuals must be able to:

- express their point of view,
- · obtain human intervention,
- obtain an explanation of the decision and challenge it.



PERSONAL DATA BREACH

A data breach is a security incident leading to the accidental or unlawful access to, destruction, misuse, loss, etc. of personal data.

The EU General Data Protection Regulation introduces a duty on all organisations to report personal data breaches to the relevant Supervisory Authorities (Data Protection Authorities) and inform those individuals of a breach, under certain delays and conditions.

Legal framework and background

The new Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, also known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), entered into force on 24 May 2016. The GDPR repeals Directive 95/46/EC, which has been, for more than 20 years, the base of the European data protection regulatory framework.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) has been applying since 25 May 2018 and it modernises data protection rules and introduces new important data protection rights such as the right to data portability and right to erasure of personal data (right to be forgotten).

One of the main goals of the GDPR is to empower data subjects, namely citizens, to better control their personal data. Reading and understanding a regulation is not an easy task and to ensure the success of the GDPR it is important that citizens are aware of their data protection rights and understand how to exercise them to control their data and mitigate privacy and security risks.

To our known, the Cyber Chronix initiative is a first experience towards employing edutainment tools, more specifically in the format of branching story-telling comics, to raise awareness of data protection rights and illustrate some of the fundamental principles of the GDPR to youngsters.

Cyber Chronix contributes to the debate on how digital technology can support the enhancement of digital competences among youngsters.
