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





- Automatically generates text captions during recording
- Best suited to software/computer-based training and instruction

Drawbacks

 Doesn't do true onscreen video captures (will allow true video capture but will not include text captioning, editable mouse motion, etc.)

Techsmith Camtasia

\$149/\$299

Benefits

- Excellent onscreen video capture
- Works well with PowerPoint

Drawbacks

Only allows multiple choice assessments

Qarbon ViewletBuilder

with ViewletCam

\$159/\$299 \$248/\$398

Benefits

- Smaller file sizes
- Works on Mac and Linux operating systems

Drawbacks

Requires ViewletCam to allow onscreen video capture
