Why is resource sharing important?

- Not everything is online. Not everything is free.
- Increase in number of publications.
- Increase in subscription costs.

No library can own or license everything their users might want.

Why is international resource sharing important?

- The libraries of each country cannot own or license every publication from every country.
- To spread knowledge of your country's literature and culture beyond your borders.
- To create scholars and advocates around the world.

Why is international resource sharing important?

A scientist from Liberia said after the Ebola outbreak...

"Part of the problem is that none of these articles were co-written by a Liberian scientist. The investigators collected their samples, returned home and published the startling results in European medical journals. Few Liberians were then trained in laboratory or epidemiological methods. Even today, downloading one of the papers would cost a physician here \$45, about half a week's salary."


