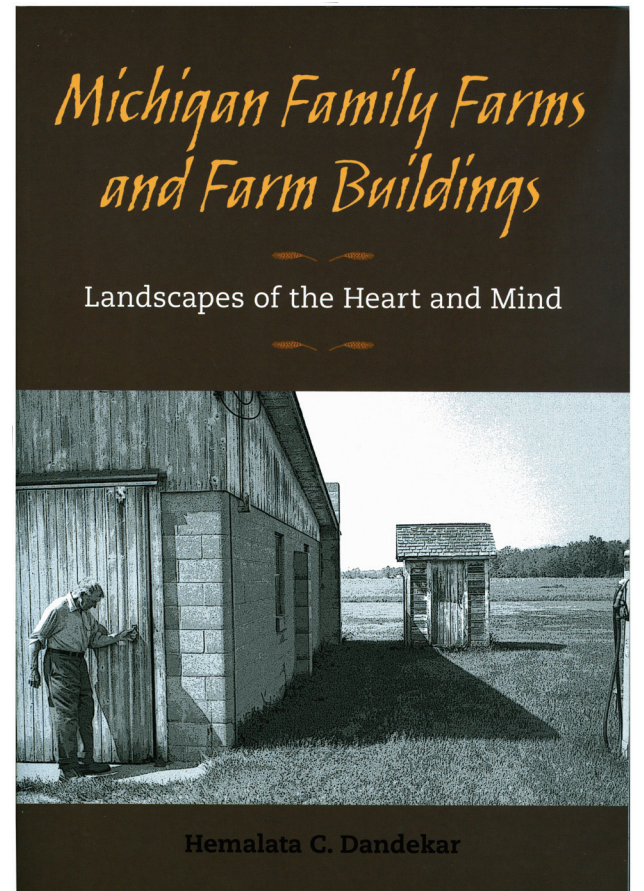
**ROBERT E. KENNEDY LIBRARY INTRODUCES
