Brazil: U.S. Lifts Trade Sanctions

On June 27, US Trade Representative Carla Hills announced her government's decision to lift economic sanctions imposed on Brazil in 1989 which affected \$39 billion in exports to the US. The sanctions were imposed after Brazil was accused of "pirating" certain pharmaceutical products patented by US companies. Special tariffs were added to Brazilian paper products, electrical appliances and several categories of pharmaceutical products. In late April, Brazil was also removed from a list of nations subject to special monitoring under the Super 301 trade bill. (Basic data from Notimex, 06/27/90)
