Swartz, David Lockington, and Thomas Wilkins. In 2003, Audrey made the decision to move to northern Michigan to attend the Interlochen Arts Academy where she studied with Julie Schleif. While at Interlochen, Ms. Destito participated in lessons with important horn players that include Francis Orval, Norman Schweikert, and Thomas Bacon. In 2005, Audrey traveled to Boston where she spent a year at Boston University studying with Eric Ruske. Ms. Destito is currently pursuing a Bachelor of Music degree at Lynn University, studying with Greg Miller.


