Aziz Sapaev, the winner of the First Prize in the First International Young Musicians' competition held among most prestigious musical institutions in Turkey, winner of the first prize in national cello competition in Edirne, Turkey, winner of the third prize in the 5th International Young Musical Talents, has been engaged in solo concerts in most prestigious concert halls as Grand Hall of Tchaikovsky Conservatory in Moscow, Russia, CRR concert hall in Istanbul, Turkey.

Born in Tashkent, Uzbekistan into a family of musicians Aziz has been introduced to classical music at an early age. Mr. Sapaev started his cello studies as a 13 year old at Uspenskiy's School for Musically Gifted Children in Tashkent, Uzbekistan. Next year Aziz was invited in Trakya University in Turkey where he completed his middle-school and high-school education. During the years of education he has been engaged in solo, chamber music and orchestral concerts in different cities of Turkey. Aziz has enrolled in Master Classes with worldwide famous teachers such as Orlando Cole, and Tobias Kühne. Actively involved in chamber music performances, Aziz has performed with leading Turkish musicians such As Gülşen Tatu, Rüşen Güneş and Özcan Ulucan. As a Member of ALUES string quartet, in March 2007, he performed the World Premiere of Bruce Polay's String Quartet commissioned by Lynn Universiy. As an orchestra musician, Mr. Sapaev has played under baton of Jon Robertson, George A. Schram and Daniel Oren. As of now, Aziz is pursuing his Bachelors Degree at Lynn University as a student of David Cole.

# Thursday, February 12 GREGORY MILLER IN RECITAL


