Ilie Curteanu was born in 1983 in Romania to a musical family and began playing the cello at age 8. Throughout high school and college he has attended master classes with world renowned cellists such as Alexandru Morosanu (Romania), Wolfgang Hertzer (Austria), Dimitrie Motatu (Spain), Laszlo Varga (Hungary-America) and Yehuda Hanani (U.S). During 2003-2007, Ilie has performed as a soloist and chamber musician in

South Florida and as an orchestral musician he has played with major orchestras such as the South West Florida Symphony, the New Philharmonic, and the Symphony of the Americas and Palm Beach Symphony. He had many recitals, concerts and live radio broadcasts, such as the Romanian Radio Broadcasting Hall "Mihail Jora" and National Television. He has performed as a soloist in the year 2001 with the "Bacau Symphony Orchestra" and "Galati Symphony Orchestra". Ilie won several international and national competitions such as: "Citta di Pietra Ligure" in 1999 (1 prize Absolute and Special prize) and 2000, National Olympiads (1997, 1998, and 2001), Bacau National Competition (2001), Garabet Avachian National Competition (2001). As a very promising young cellist, Ilie was awarded a scholarship at the Lynn University Conservatory of Music in 2002 for his Undergraduate degree and is currently completing his Master's Degree, studying with renowned professor David Cole.


