Chao Li, trombone

As a member of the Beijing Trombone Quartet, Chao Li was a first prize recipient of the China Woodwind and Brass Wind Ensemble Competition in 1998. Chao also has been principal trombonist of the China Youth Symphony, performing throughout Asia including Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong, Taiwan and in major cities in China. His orchestral work includes collaborations with Maestro Zubin Mehta, Seizi Ozawa, and the members of the Vienna Philharmonic, broadcast at the CCTV (China Central TV Station). As principal trombonist, Chao made two recordings with the China Youth Symphony performing Mussorgsky's *Pictures at an Exhibition*, Prokofiev's *Romeo and Juliet*, and Beethoven's *Symphony No. 5*. In 1999, Chao performed with Irvin Wagner, the former president of the International Trombone Association, in a recital in Beijing.

Born in Beijing on January 23rd 1978, Chao attended the China Central Conservatory of Music at age of 12, where he studied with Professor Fu Li and Bing-Yu Hu. He participated in master classes of Joe Alessi of the New York Philharmonic, Per Brevig of the Metropolitan Opera, the Canadian Brass Quintet, and the Empire Brass Quintet. Currently enrolled at the Conservatory of Music at Lynn University on full-scholarship, Chao is studying with Mark Hetzler of the Empire Brass, and is expecting his BM from Lynn University in the May of 2003. He loves Jazz and music of many styles.
