- Performance instructions for preliminary and final rounds:

<u>Preliminary</u>: A ten-minute audition with excerpts from the submitted work selected by the contestant. Contestants are encouraged to include sections from each movement of multiple movement works.

<u>Final</u>: The final round will be a performance of the complete work, unless it is longer than thirty minutes. If so, the work needs to be cut to make a thirty-minute version that includes portions of all movements. Long orchestral tuttis should be cut in both rounds of the competition.
