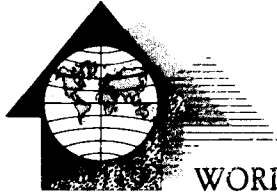

Welcome to Oslo!

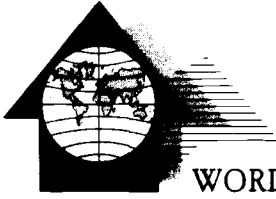

SITE VISITS

All day The Norwegian Ministry of Environment has organized an all day site visit to:

1. The Øra Wetland Nature Reserve
2. The RAIN project on Acid Rain Measurement
3. Elkem A/S Fiskaa Verk (a commercial factory, producing metal alloys) to view their industrial waste disposal system.

08.30 h A bus will collect all participants in the visit outside the Sheraton Hotel.

Lunch will be held at Fredriksten Fort, and will be attended by the Mayor of Fredriksten.

Dinner will be hosted by the Plant Manager of Fiskaa Verk. The Mayor of Kristiansand and local dignitaries will be present.

The Minister of Environment, Mrs Rakél Surlien, and Messrs Jan Thompson and Rolf Selrod of the same ministry will join in the site visits, before the departure from Oslo. Two or three journalists will also accompany the group.

Please note that much of the day will be spent outdoors, and that you will be travelling by boat and on small sea planes. You are therefore advised to wear warm and comfortable clothing: rainwear is also recommended.

SATURDAY, 22 June

All day Site visits have been organized in the Bergen area to:

1. Two fish farms
2. Kværner Brug and Norwave, wave power plants.

A bus will collect all tour participants at 06.15 h outside the Hotel, to catch the 07.00 h flight to Bergen.

From Bergen, tour participants will take a chartered boat to the fish farms, and be briefed on aquaculture by the R and D Manager of the Norwegian Institute of Marine Research.

There will also be a briefing by the Project Manager of Kværner Brug A/S, on the wave power plant, which they are building and a short film on the Norwave A/S wave power project.

Lunch will be held at Måken, and will be attended by the Mayor, Vice Mayor and Counsellor of Øygarden and their wives.

The return flight to Oslo is scheduled to leave Bergen at 16.20 h. Participants will return to the Hotel shortly after 17.00 h.

As for the previous day, warm and comfortable clothing is recommended.

All day      Separate Media Seminar for Environmental Journalists at the Info-Rama Center which is adjacent to the Hotel. The Seminar is being sponsored by the World Commission on Environment and Development and organized by Earthscan. It will be attended by 20 to 25 journalists from all over the world and opened by Mrs Brundtland.

Details will be circulated separately to each Commissioner by Earthscan.

This is a FREE DAY for other WCED participants though Commissioners who are available at lunchtime are invited to join the journalists at 12.15 hours for an informal lunch in the banqueting room off the lobby of the Hotel Sheraton.

During the morning an optional site-seeing tour of the area in and around Oslo has been arranged for WCED participants and spouses who wish to take part. A bus will leave from the hotel at 10.00 hours and should return around 13.00 hours. The tour includes a visit to:

- the famous Holmenkollen skijump
- the Vigeland Sculpture Park
- the Viking Museum

No plans have been made for the afternoon.
