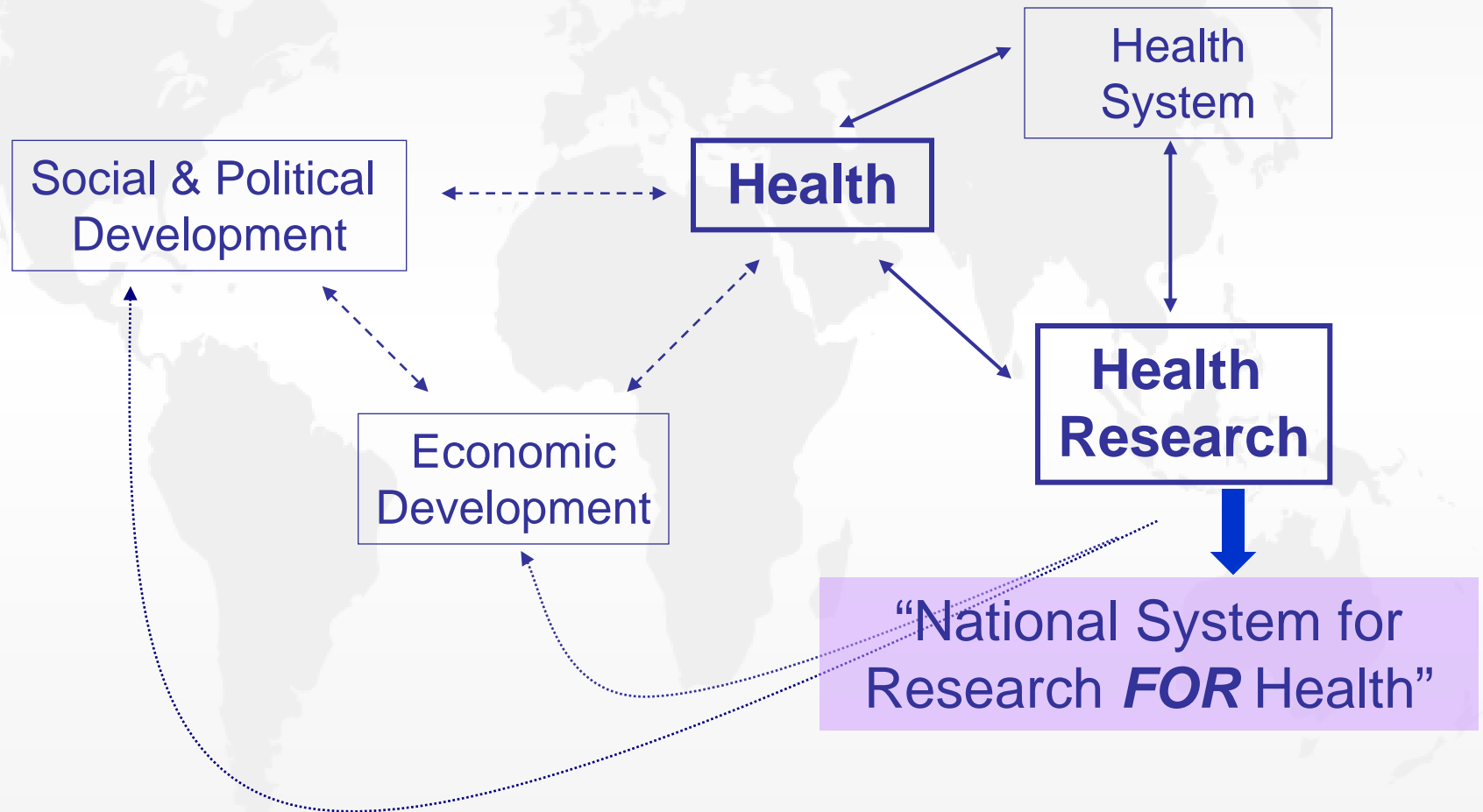

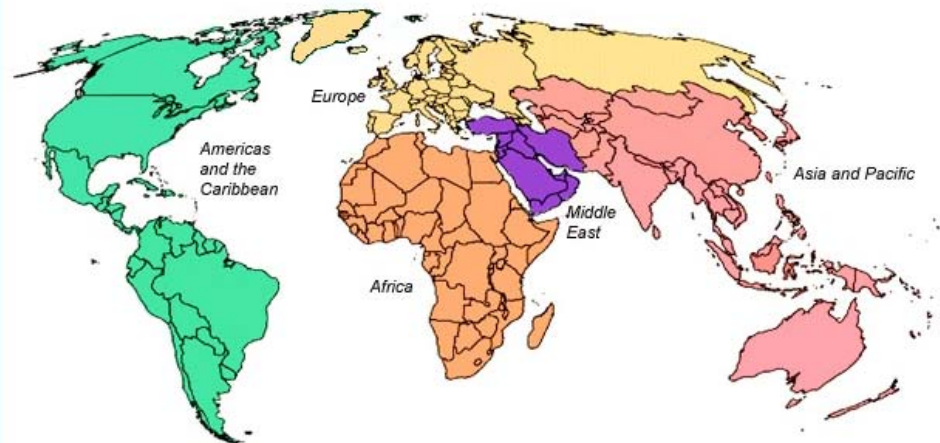

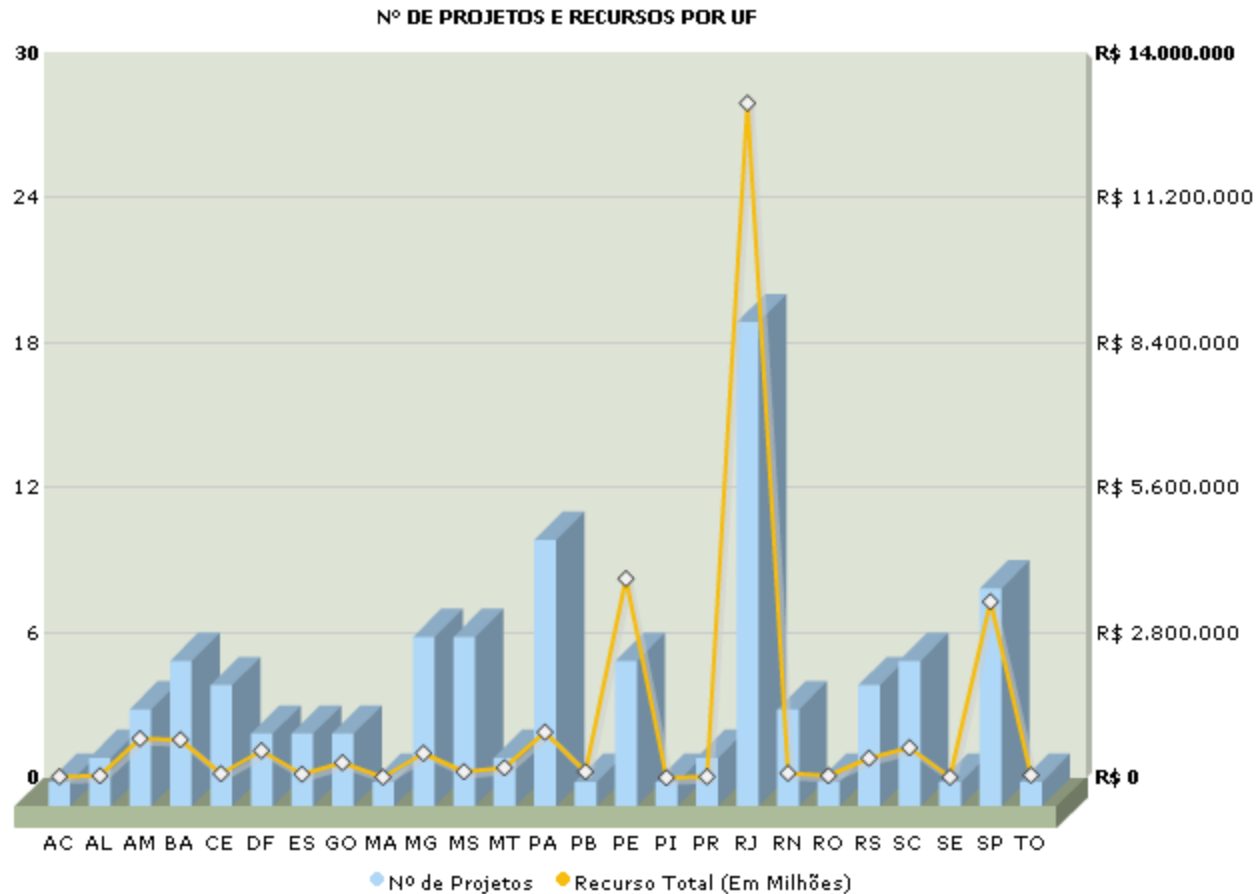

## Research on HIV Aids Financed by Department of Science and Technology Brazil

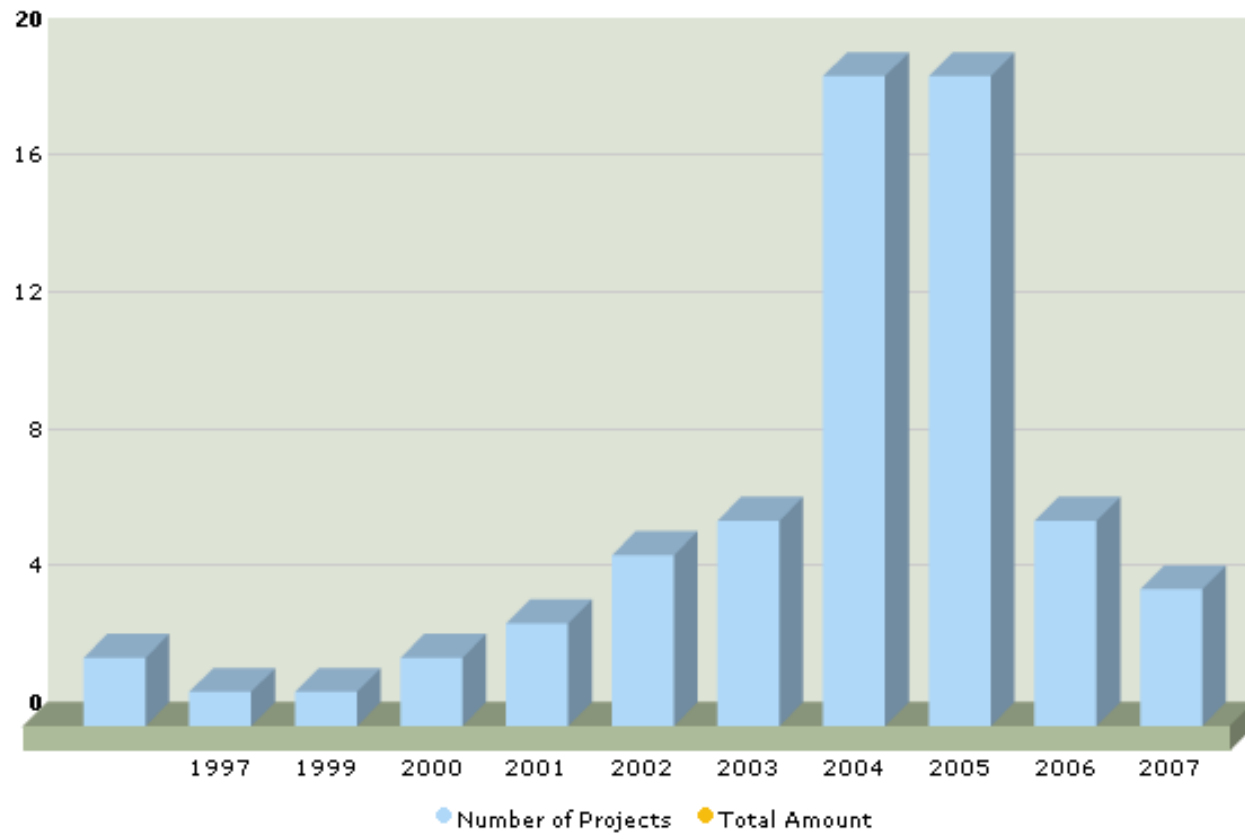
