The Library Liaison Program of Zach S. Henderson Library is an outreach initiative that bridges the library and the classroom through learning, engagement, and collaboration among librarians, faculty, staff, and students of the university. As faculty members, librarians collaborate with faculty and staff on the following:

Information Literacy: Librarians provide instruction to students, faculty, and staff to further understanding of information resources within and across the curriculum

Research and Scholarship: Librarians advise faculty, staff, and students in areas of research and scholarship to expand their scholarly activities and output

Collection Development: Librarians build library collections with faculty and staff to better support and create curriculum and research opportunities of the university

Digital Commons@Georgia Southern

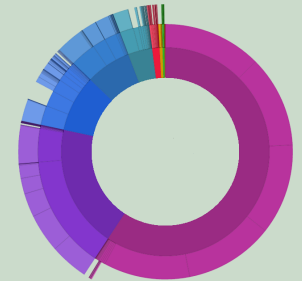

Journals and Conferences: You can request an individual journal and/or conference site that has an entire built-in peer-review process!

Grey Literature: Do you have documents not currently published but want to make available? Digital Commons can store videos, images, datasets, textbooks, etc.
