Profiles & Metrics

SelectedWorks compile your information and scholarship in one place with options to upload materials or link to sites that contain your work.

Plum Analytics list the altmetrics (usage, captures, mentions, social media, citations) for your publications and presentations.

When your profiles are created, you will automatically be added to Georgia Southern's **Expertise Search**.

Journals & Conferences

Digital Commons journal and conference sites are customizable and have a built-in peer-review process from submission to decision.

Data Curation

Many funding agencies and publishers now require that research data be made publicly available. Also, sharing data increases visibility and opportunities for collaboration.

Curate data in Digital Commons, ICPSR, and other data repositories available through the library. Contact the library to explore curation options as you prepare research and grant proposals.
