Process Notes: The team coordinator(s) will be selected by the team members for a specified period of time; terms may be renewed. Each summer the team membership will be reviewed and library personnel will be invited to volunteer to be members, or asked if they wish to rotate off the team.

Team meeting agendas will be prepared in advance and sent to Zach-I, with an invitation for interested personnel to attend. Meeting essence notes, consisting of a brief summary of topics addressed, will be distributed via Zach-I and archived in Digital Commons. Team recommendations for policies and procedures must be ratified by the Dean of the Library.
